



Instructions: Please make the following changes and adhere to the following clarifications on the bid referenced above.

Proposed Amendments / Changes / Clarifications:

1. Proposal:
 - a. **Project Special Provisions, Roadway, Page R-2-REV, Notes to Contractor:** the provision has been updated to include additional items, as follows:
 12. Contractors, including Primes and Subcontractors, working on projects on base are not required to comply with the requirements of Executive Order 14042.
 13. Compliance with Federal Wage Rates is not required.
 14. Utility locates on Fort Bragg are coordinated by calling 910-396-0325. The length of time it takes to obtain locates varies based on demand, with current wait times of a minimum of 2 – 4 weeks being experienced.
 15. **Water for Milling Operations:** Water can be obtained on a reimbursable basis. To set up an account, contact Mr. Robert Edge at robert.b.edge.civ@mail.mil or robert.b.edge.civ@army.mil. The current non-federal rate for water is **\$11.51337 per Thousand Gallons.**

16. **ICT 2:** The intent of ICT 2 is to designate Map 1 – Honeycutt Road, as a “Nighttime Work Only” route. However, Knox Street ACP, Gate 8A, which is the designated entrance gate for trucks and equipment, only operates from 5:00 AM until 9:00 PM daily.

To access the Base outside of the standard operating hours, the following protocol must be followed:

- a. All Personnel (Contractors, Subcontractors, Inspectors, etc.) must have an Automated Installation Entry (AIE) Badge and/or Pass, as detailed above.
- b. NCDOT and/or Wetherill Engineering, in conjunction with the Contractor, shall produce a spreadsheet with a list of all personnel and equipment needing afterhours access, and shall provide this information to Base Officials.
- c. Base Officials shall be made aware of a designated, overall Supervisor/Point of Contact.
- d. Once approved, personnel and equipment will be permitted to use the Honeycutt Road ACP, Gate 10, for the afterhours construction entry.
