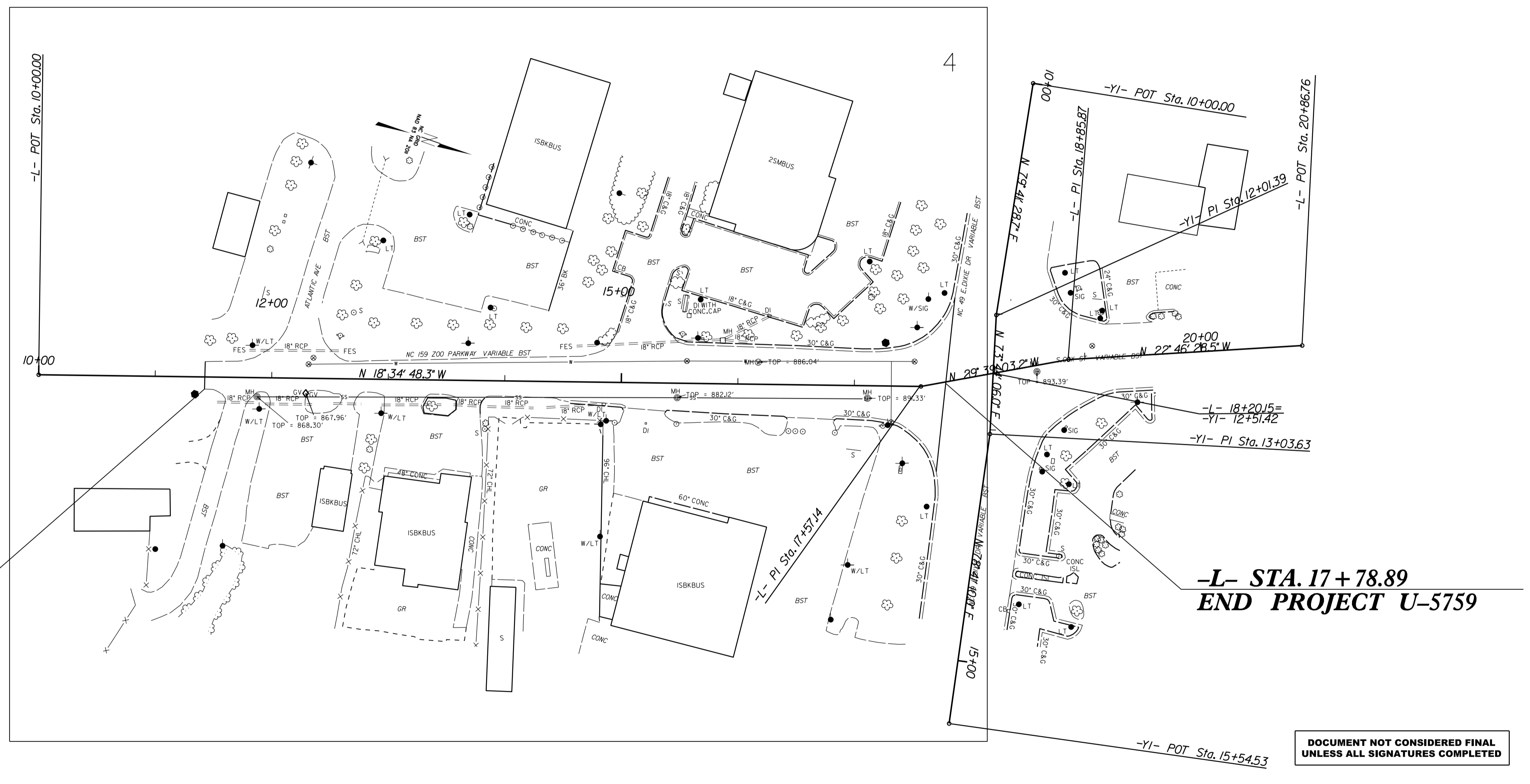

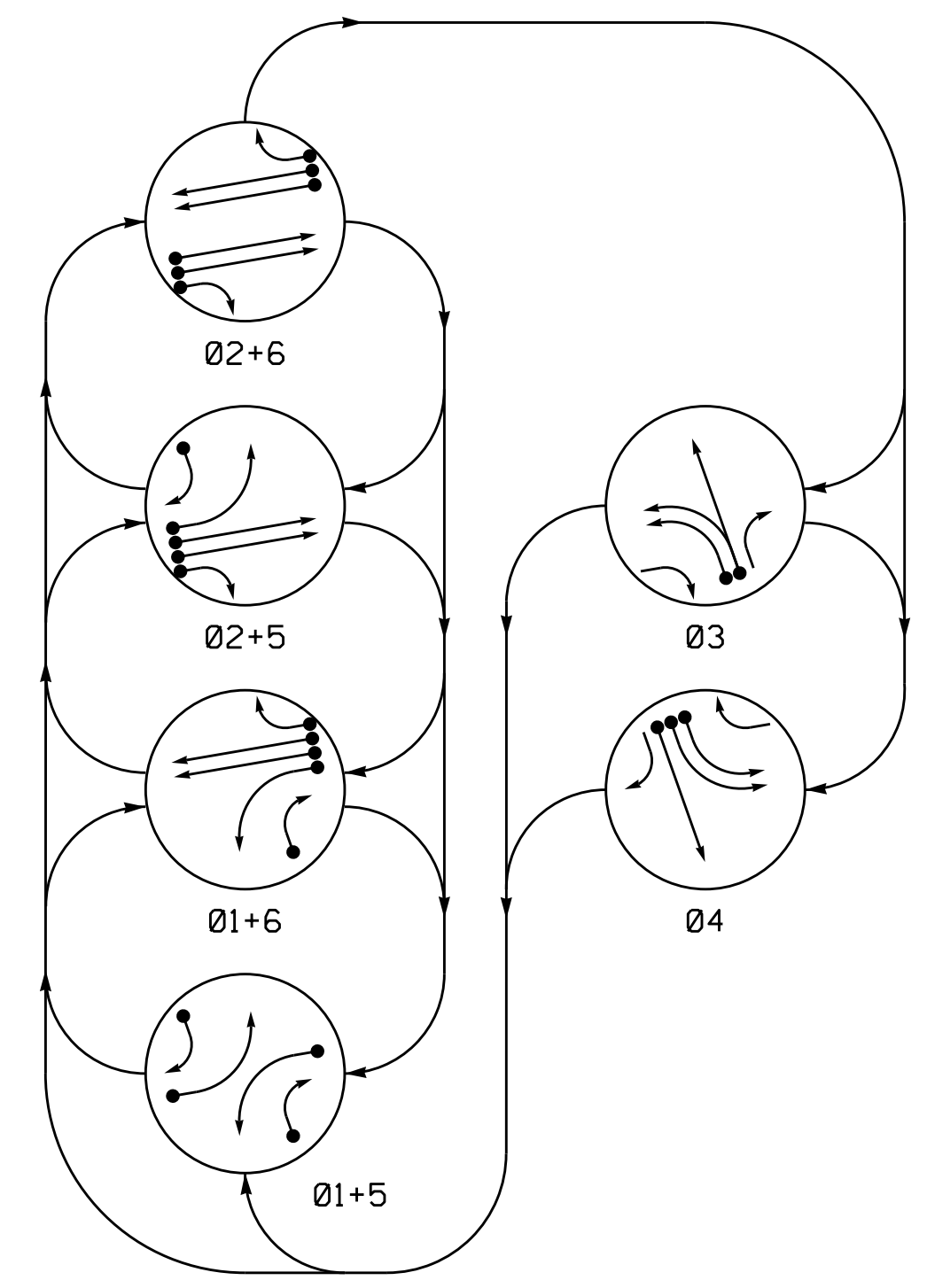

PHASING DIAGRAM DETECTION LEGEND

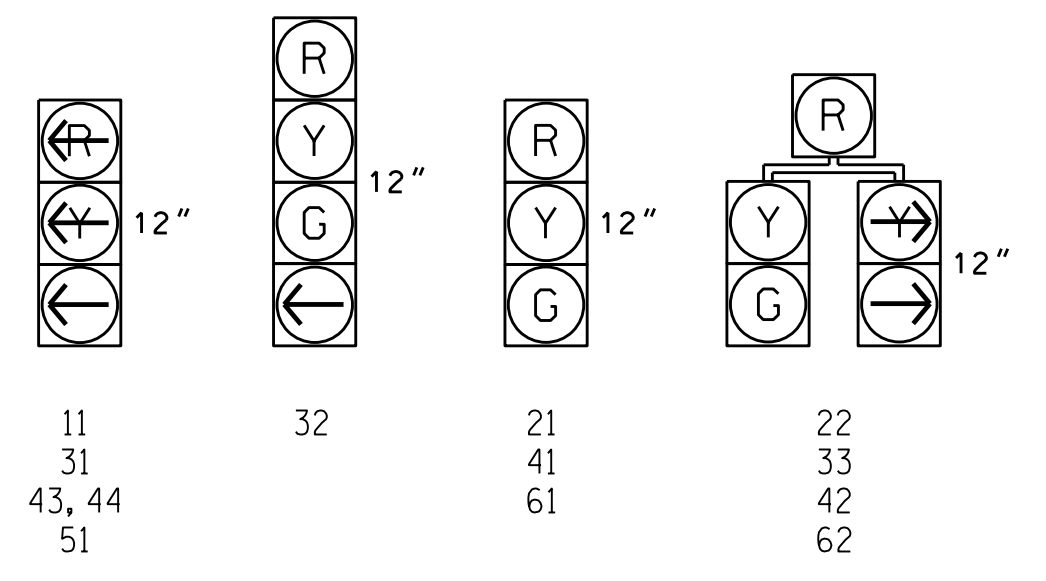

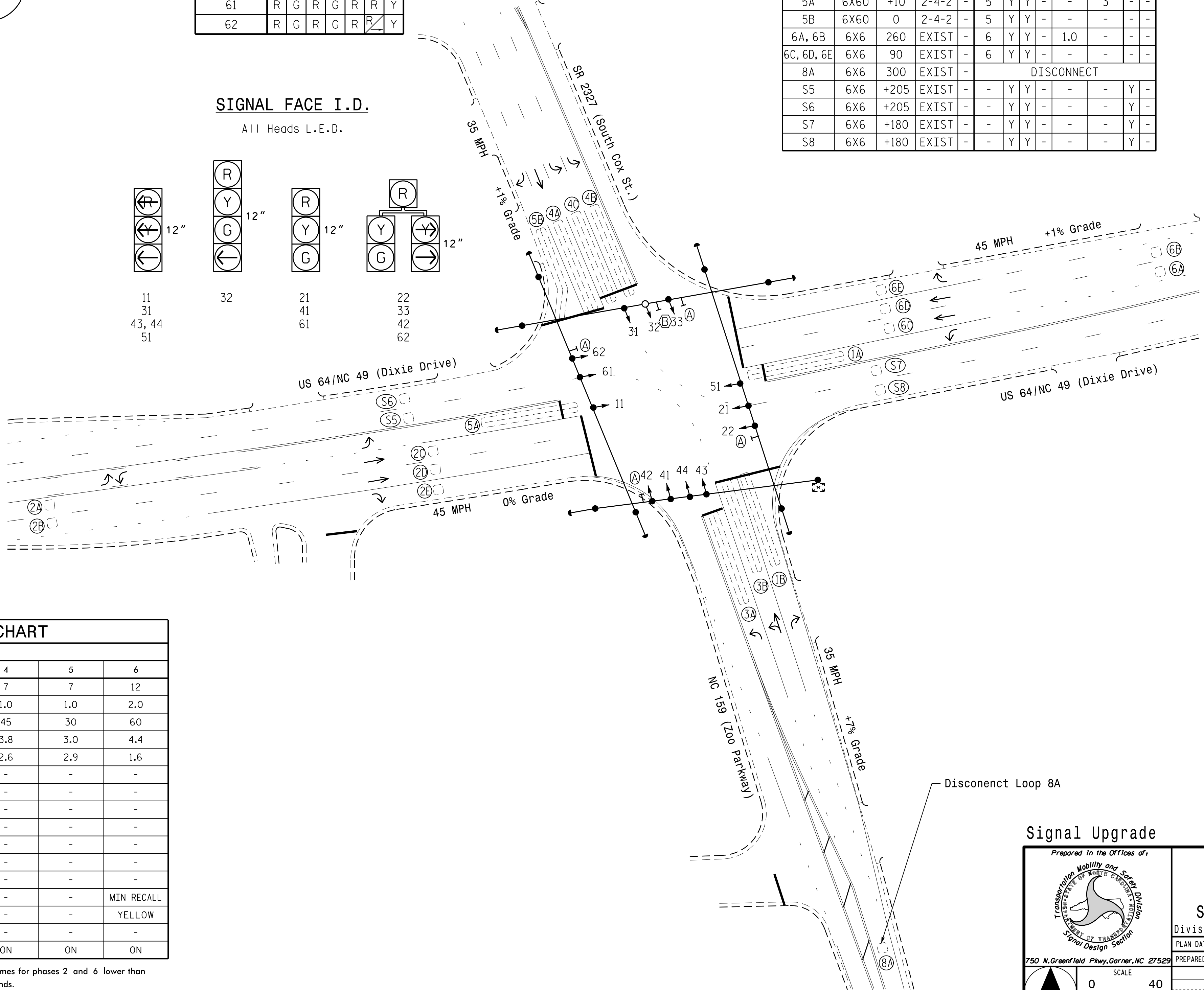

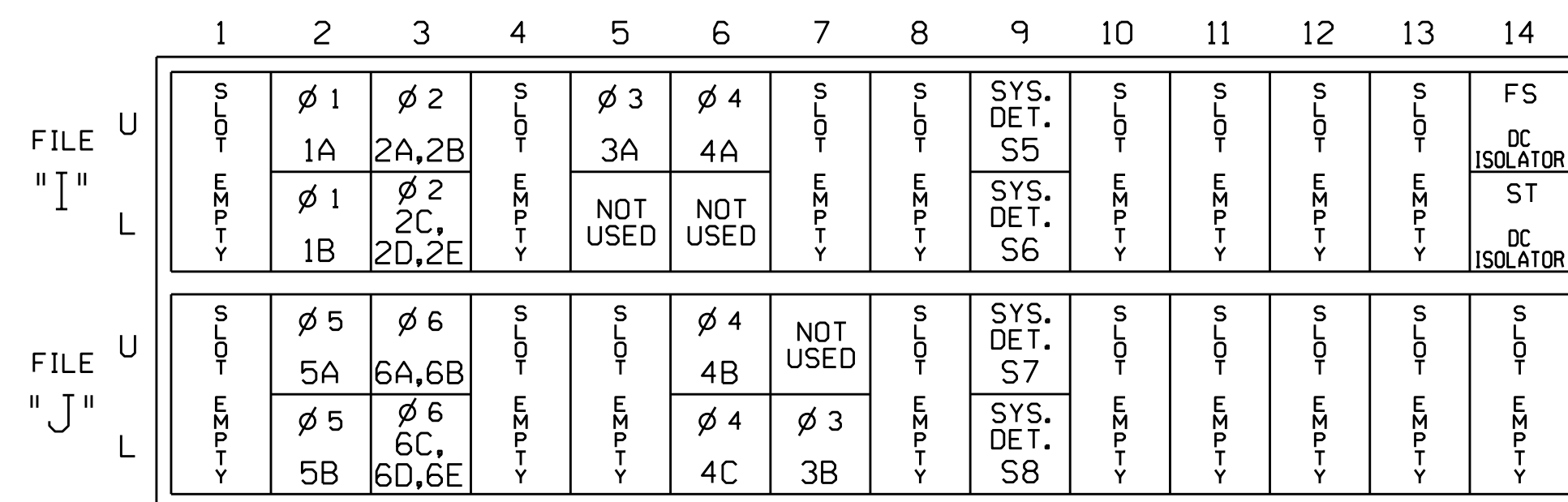

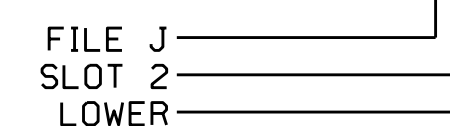

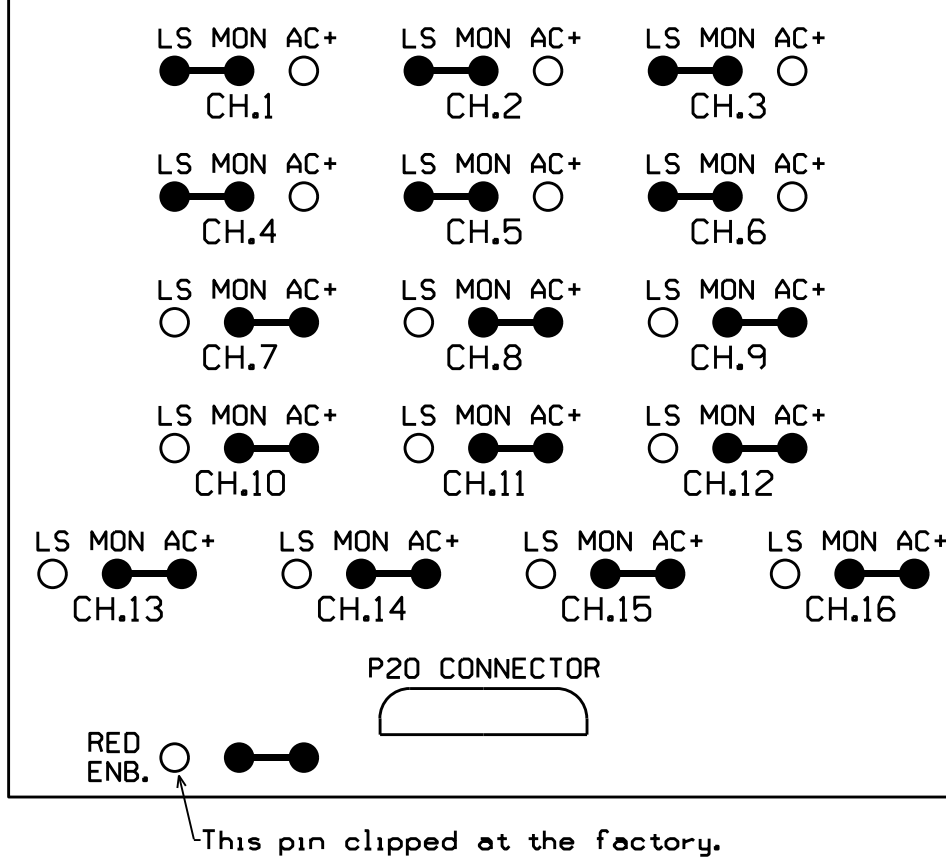
