

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed Bids will be received by the City of Asheboro (OWNER) at the Council Chambers at City Hall, 146 N. Church Street, Asheboro, North Carolina 27203, until **APRIL 28, 2022, 2:00 pm**, for TIP Number: EB-5862.

At said place and time, and promptly thereafter, all Bids that have been duly received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The proposed Work is generally described as follows:

The EB-5862 project consists of sidewalk along Industrial Park Avenue from the parking lot at Entrance B to Randolph Community College to just east of Enterprise Street including curb and gutter and associated storm drainage as necessary.

All Bids must be in accordance with the Bidding Documents on file with the: City of Asheboro Planning & Zoning Department

Electronic Copies of the Bidding Documents are located on the City of Asheboro's website at https://www.asheboronc.gov/businesses/bidding_opportunities.php.

Pursuant to Section 143-133.3 of the General Statutes of North Carolina (the "General Statutes"), the City of Asheboro will not enter into a contract for services unless the successful bidder, and the bidder's subcontractors, comply with the requirements of Chapter 64, Article 2 of the General Statutes. The said statutory provisions establish North Carolina's E-Verify requirements for employers. In order to be responsive to the request for proposals and, if successful as a bidder, to satisfy the contract formation requirements, the successful bidder must contractually agree with the city that the bidder and its subcontractors who perform work on this Project are compliant, and will remain compliant throughout the duration of the Project, with Chapter 64, Article 2 of the General Statutes.

Notice of Federal Funding. EB-5862 will receive federal funding. All prospective bidders or offerors must acknowledge that funding is contingent upon compliance with all terms and conditions of the funding award.

Bidders are required to be prequalified with NCDOT as Bidders or PO Prime Contractors prior to submitting a bid. Information regarding prequalification can be found at: <https://connect.ncdot.gov/business/Prequal/Pages/default.aspx>.

Bids will be received on a unit price basis.

The Successful Bidder will be required to furnish a Construction Performance Bond and a Construction Payment Bond as security for the faithful performance and the payment of all bills and obligations arising from the performance of the Contract.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all Bids. Bids may be rejected for any reason determined by the Owner's governing board to be in the best interest of the City. If a contract is awarded, it will be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, taking into consideration quality, performance, and the time specified in the bids for performance of the contract. The City also reserves the right to waive informalities.

Upon award by the City Council, the City will give the Successful Bidder a Notice of Award.

No exceptions, unrequested additions, deletions, purported clarifications, and/or any other types of modifications of the proposed forms, terms, conditions, and specifications may be submitted with the bid package. No information/documentation beyond what is specifically requested is to be submitted. Any bid containing such exceptions or modifications will be deemed non-responsive, and, accordingly will not be considered.
