A Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting was held on Thursday, February 1, 2024 @ 1:00 p.m. at the North Carolina Department of Transportation, Division 9 Office in Conference Room A located at 375 Silas Creek Parkway, Winston-Salem, NC 27127. The meeting was chaired by Mr. Chuck White, Division Bridge Maintenance Engineer and Mr. Jeff Turner, Division Proposal Engineer.

This is a Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Program project, and as such, it is restricted to businesses grossing less than \$1,500,000, excluding materials, during the previous calendar year. Contractors must be certified as a SBE Contractor by the Contractual Services Unit of NCDOT and listed as such in the Directory of Transportation Firms at the time of bid opening. Pages 6-7:

All bids should be prepared and submitted in accordance with the requirements set forth on Page 6-7 of the proposal "Instructions to Bidders".

• Failure to comply with the requirements shall cause the bid to be considered irregular and shall be grounds for rejection of the bid. The **entire proposal** including bid form should be placed in a sealed envelope and delivered and received in the Division Office by 2:00 p.m. on February 14, 2024.

 - o Contract period is for one (1) year for a maximum period of three (3) years
 - o Liquidated Damages are Three Hundred (\$300.00) per hour.
- Refer to Page 13: Supervision by Contractor
- Refer to Page 14: Work Order Assignment (Multiple Awards) for ID/IQ
- Refer to Page 15: Payment (prefer invoice submitted on a two week basis)
- Contact county supervisor for utility conflicts or any other issue relating to a specific project
- Refer to Page 19: Cutting and Removal of Vegetation
 - Size of brush
 - o Minimum equipment required
 - The Department and the contractor shall communicate as to other equipment that is safe and non-damaging to complete the work
- Contact Nick Hanes daily of intended schedule of work
- Refer to Page 20: Litter Removal, Cooperation with State Forces and Traffic Control

Bid Forms:

- Mr. Turner went over the forms at the back of the contract.
 - Fill out the appropriate Non-Collusion, Debarment and Gift Ban Certification form for your company
 - o No Goals to enter so complete Subcontractor form with \$0.00
 - o Complete W9
 - Make sure Bid Form is completed properly otherwise Bid cannot be accepted.
 - Unit Price Complete calculation correctly, Unit Price Prevails if there is a discrepancy
- Mr. Turner stated that the Minutes will be sent out as Addendum #1; be sure to sign the addendum sheet acknowledging you have read the minutes and return with a bid package.

Open Discussion:

- Can the contractor use Bush Hog yes, but at the discretion of the Engineer and if the operation is safe and non-damaging to the work area.
- Fallen tree size over the contracted limit leave as is, work around the tree and NCDOT will arrange for clean-up.
- Bids can be included for the counties the contractor is willing to perform work. Not all counties are required to be bid.
