A) Duke Energy Carolinas

B) AT&T of NC

The conflicting utility owned by AT&T of NC will begin relocation 2 weeks after the attaching utilites above it on the Duke Energy poles have completed their transfers and AT&Tof NC representative is notified of their completed transfer. Buried facilities will be adjusted as necessary along Innes St. Market Drive. Pedestals will be removed and lines spliced and buried. There is a FO cable that will need to worked around during placement of the drainage facilities. One week notification for AT&T of NC to have personnel on site during work around of FO will be required.
