

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

- 5) The authorized activities shall not result in any permanent or temporary impacts to wetlands, without permit modification.
- 6) All reasonable efforts shall be made to contain all debris and excess materials associated with construction activities with the intent that debris and excess materials do not enter wetlands or waters of the State, even temporarily.
- 7) The permittee and/or his contractor shall contact the DCM Transportation Project Field Representative in Elizabeth City at (252) 264-3901 to request a preconstruction conference prior to project initiation.

Maintenance Clause

- 8) DCM shall be notified in writing at least two (2) weeks in advance of any maintenance excavation work authorized by this permit, and such notification shall include:
 - A. The number of the original permit.
 - B. A statement that no dimensional changes are proposed.
 - C. A copy of the original permit plans with cross-hatching indicating the area to be maintained, the area to be used for spoil disposal, and the estimated amount of material to be removed.
 - D. The date of plan revision and the permittee's signature shown anew on the original plan.

NOTE: The location, design, and holding capacity of the spoil disposal site shall be approved by a representative of DCM prior to the initiation of any maintenance dredging activities.

General

- 9) This project shall conform to all requirements of the N.C. Sedimentation Pollution Control Act and the N.C. Department of Transportation's (NCDOT's) Memorandum of Agreement with the N.C. Division of Energy, Mineral, and Land Resources.

NOTE: This minor modification and renewal do not eliminate the need to obtain any additional permits, approvals or authorizations that may be required.

- 10) This minor modification and renewal shall be attached to the original of Permit No. 12-87, which was issued on 1/14/87, as well as all subsequent modifications and renewals, and copies of all documents shall be readily available on site when a Division representative inspects the project for compliance.
- 11) All conditions and stipulations of the active permit remain in force under this minor modification and renewal unless altered herein.
