INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for Gel Coated Fiberglass Interpretive Panels and Frame manufacturing (Contract #1) for the Outer Banks National Scenic Byway Interpretative Plan in Dare, Hyde and Carteret Counties, North Carolina will be accepted by Dare County until 1:30 pm, on September 7, 2017.

Bids will be received by County Purchasing Agent Dustin Peele at Dare County's Administrative Office, Room 168, 954 Marshall C. Collins Dr., Manteo, NC 27954, at which time all bids will be opened publicly and read aloud. Bidders and interested parties may be present.

The scope of work for the project includes the manufacturing of the Gel Coated Fiberglass Community / Village and Kiosk Panels and Aluminum Frames for the Interpretive Plan along the entire Outer Banks National Scenic Byway within the counties of Dare, Hyde and Carteret, North Carolina. The Gel Coated Fiberglass Panels and mounting frames are to be manufactured in accordance with the Project Specifications and in accordance with the Project Documents.

Sealed bids may be mailed to Dustin Peele, Purchasing Agent, Dare County, P.O. Box 1000, Manteo, NC 27954. It is the bidder's responsibility to make sure that the bid is received at the bid opening location.

A pre-bid conference will not be held. Bidders are strongly encouraged to review the project parameters prior to the pre-bid conference. This pre-bid meeting is not mandatory.
