All bids shall be prepared and submitted in accordance with the following requirements. Failure to comply with any requirement shall cause the bid to be considered irregular and shall be grounds for rejection of the bid.

- The bid sheet furnished by NCDOT with the proposal shall be used and shall not be altered in any manner. DO NOT SEPARATE THE BID SHEET FROM THE PROPOSAL!
- 2. All entries on the bid sheet, including signatures, shall be written in ink.
- **3.** The Bidder shall submit a unit price for every item on the bid form. The unit prices for the various contract items shall be written in figures.

The award of the contract, if it be awarded, will be made to the lowest responsible Bidder in accordance with Section 102 (excluding 102-2 and 102-10) of the Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures 2012. The lowest responsible will be notified that his bid has been accepted and that he has been awarded the contract. NCDOT reserves the right to reject all bids.

SMALL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PURCHASE ORDER CONTRACT Standard Provisions

GENERAL

This contract is to provide Trucks for daily transport and stockpiling for the Bituminous Department in accordance with all specifications and as directed by the Engineer. Trucks for "Daily Transport and Stockpiling" will be at various sites in Mecklenburg, Union, Cabarrus, Stanly and Anson Counties.

All work and materials shall be in accordance with the provisions of the general guidelines of this Contract, the Project Special Provisions, the North Carolina Department of Transportation <u>Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures 2012</u>, the North Carolina Department of Transportation <u>Roadway Standards Drawings</u>, and the current edition of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).

The Contractor shall keep himself fully informed of all Federal, State, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations, and shall comply with the provisions of Section 107 of the <u>Standard Specifications</u>.

SMALL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM

This is a Small Business Enterprise Program project, and as such, will be restricted to businesses with a gross income of not more than 1.5 million during the previous calendar year. The Department's normal bonding and Contractor license requirements will be waived.

Only Contractors currently certified as a SBE Contractor by the Contractual Services Unit of the NCDOT and listed in the Directory of Transportation Firms at bid opening will be eligible to bid on this project. Proof of small business status will be the previous year's income tax return. A copy of this return does not have to be submitted with this bid proposal, but may be requested at a later date.

Prospective bidders who qualify for the SBE Program and are not currently certified should submit a completed application packet prior to bid submittal to allow for review time. The application packet and additional information on the program may be obtained online at: http://www.ncdot.org/business/ocs/sbe/, Contractors can also go to https://apps.dot.state.nc.us/vendor/directory/ for additional information.

CONTRACT TIME

This contract will be effective for twelve (12) months. The Date of Availability for this contract is **May 1**st, **2012** and the Completion Date is **May 1**st, **2013**. The contractor shall submit a bid for one year. The total annual contract expenditures shall not exceed the maximum SBE value of \$500,000.

At the option of the Department of Transportation, based on the Contractor's satisfactory performance of the terms contained herein, this agreement may be extended additional periods of one (1) year each up to a maximum total contract time of three (3) years, with the same terms and conditions. Each renewal year the "Hourly Rate" defined elsewhere in this contract, will be adjusted according to the **Consumer Price Index (CPI)**.

The Engineer will notify the Contractor in writing 30 days before annual expiration date. The Contractor must notify the Engineer within 15 days after receiving notice of his acceptance of this offer. Failure on the part of the Contractor to reply will be received as a rejection of contract extension.

CONTRACT TIME AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

The date of availability for this contract is May 1st, 2012 as stated above. The Engineer or a duly authorized representative will notify the Contractor when trucks for hauling are needed. This Notification will occur a minimum of 24 hours prior to the services being required. When notified, the Contractor, will report to the designated location with the approved number of trucks and drivers. The Contractor must report for work no later than the time designated on the day that his services are needed. Failure to do so will result in the assessment of liquidated damages.

No work will be permitted and the purchase order will not be issued until all required insurance certifications have been satisfied.

No extensions will be authorized except as authorized by Article 108-10 of the Standard Specifications.

Liquidated damages for this contract are Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per hour until the approved number of trucks with driver has arrived at designated location.

AUTHORITY OF THE ENGINEER

The Engineer for this project shall be the Division Engineer, Division 10, Division of Highways, North Carolina Department of Transportation, acting directly or through his duly authorized representatives.

The Engineer will decide all questions which may arise as to the quality and acceptability of work performed and as to the rate of progress of the work; all questions which may arise as to the interpretation of the contract; and all questions as to the acceptable fulfillment of the contract on the part of the Contractor. His decision shall be final and he shall have executive authority to enforce and make effective such decisions and orders as the Contractor fails to carry out promptly.

SUBLETTING OF CONTRACT

The Contractor shall not sublet, sell, transfer, assign or otherwise dispose of this contract or any portion thereof; or his right, title, or interest therein; without written consent of the Engineer. Subletting of this contract or any portion of the contract shall conform to the requirements of Article of 108-6 of the <u>Standard Specifications</u>.

DEFAULT OF CONTRACT

The Department of Transportation shall have the right to declare a default of contract for breach by the Contractor of any material term or condition of the contract. Default of contract shall be in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures of Article 108-9 of the <u>Standard Specifications</u>.

CLAIMS FOR ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION OR EXTENSION OF TIME

Any claims for additional compensation and/or extensions of the completion date shall be submitted to the Division Engineer with detailed justification within sixty (60) days after receipt of the final invoice payment. The failure of the Contractor to submit the claim(s) within sixty days shall be a bar to recovery.

PAYMENT

Payment will be made at the contract unit price. Prices and payment will be full compensation for all work covered.

The Contractor may submit a request for partial payment on a monthly basis, or other interval as approved by the Engineer. The amount of partial payments will be based on the work accomplished and accepted as the last day of the approved pay period.

All work items necessary to complete the work other than listed on the "Bid Form" will be considered incidental in nature and no further compensation will be made. Any work performed in an unsatisfactory manner could be a basis for cancellation of the contract.

PROSECUTION AND PROGRESS

The Contractor shall pursue the work diligently with workmen in sufficient numbers, abilities, and supervision, and with equipment, materials, and methods of construction as may be required to complete the work described in the contract by the completion date and in accordance with Section 108 of the Standard Specifications.

CONTRACT BID QUANTITIES

This is a yearly needs contract. The quantity shown on the bid sheet is an estimate of the hours that "Trucks for <u>Daily Transport & Stockpiling</u>" will be needed by the department throughout the year. The actual hours of hauling may be more or less than the amount shown on the bid sheet.

NOTE: The Contractor should also be aware that due to weather and seasonal limitations the majority of hauling hours required in this contract and any renewals would be during the months of April through November.

OUTSOURCING OUTSIDE THE USA

(9-21-04) (Rev. 5-16-06) SP1 G150

All work on consultant contracts, services contracts, and construction contracts shall be performed in the United States of America. No work shall be outsourced outside of the United States of America.

Outsourcing for the purpose of this provision is defined as the practice of subcontracting labor, work, services, staffing, or personnel to entities located outside of the United States.

GIFTS FROM VENDORS AND CONTRACTORS

General Statute 143C-6-11. (h) Highway Appropriation is hereby incorporated verbatim in this contract as follows:

(h) Amounts Encumbered. – Transportation project appropriations may be encumbered in the amount of allotments made to the Department of Transportation by the Director for the estimated payments for transportation project contract work to be performed in the appropriation fiscal year. The allotments shall be multiyear allotments and shall be based on estimated revenues and shall be subject to the maximum contract authority contained in *General Statute 143C-6-11(c)*. Payment for transportation project work performed pursuant to contract in any fiscal year other than the current fiscal year is subject to appropriations by the General Assembly. Transportation project contracts shall contain a schedule of estimated completion progress, and any acceleration of this progress shall be subject to the approval of the Department of Transportation provided funds are available. The State reserves the right to terminate or suspend any transportation project contract, and any transportation project contract shall be so terminated or suspended if funds will not be available for payment of the work to be performed during that fiscal year pursuant to the contract. In the event of termination of any contract, the contractor shall be given a written notice of termination at least 60 days before completion of scheduled work for which funds are available. In the event of termination, the contractor shall be paid for the work already performed in accordance with the contract specifications.

Payment will be made on any contract terminated pursuant to the special provision in accordance with Subarticle 108-13(E) of the 2012 Standard Specifications.
