Sealed bids for the project entitled **B-5988** will be received by the **Town of Wadesboro** at **124 East Wade Street, Wadesboro, North Carolina 28170** until **2:00 PM** local time on **Wednesday, July 6, 2022**. At said place and time, all Bids that have been duly received, will be publicly opened and read aloud at the **Wadesboro Fire Department** located at **205 East Morgan Street, Wadesboro, North Carolina 28170**.

THE PROJECT GENERALLY CONSISTS OF the furnishing of all materials, labor and equipment for the construction of a single span, cored slab bridge, the associated roadway approaches, any related work including, but not limited to, sewer line utility work, existing structure demolition and removal as required by the Contract Documents and Contract Drawings.

The Bidding Documents for the project may be examined online through Quest Construction Data Network (QuestCDN). This can be done via the QUESTCDN website (www.questcdn.com). QuestCDN is a web-based platform for construction project advertisements, bid documents distribution and plan holder lists. Prospective bidders will need the seven-digit QuestCDN project number **#8111362** to locate the job on the QuestCDN website search page. There is a \$30 nonrefundable cost for downloading the contract documents in a pdf format. Contact QuestCDN Customer Support at 952-233-1632 or info@questcdn.com for assistance in membership registration and downloading digital request information.

Subsurface information is available on the structure portion of this project and may be obtain as part of the Bidding Documents found on the QuestCDN website.

Each bid shall be accompanied with a certified or cashier's check drawn on a bank or trust company insured by the FDIC or a Bid Bond prepared on the form of Bid Bond contained in the Bidding Documents or a Surety Company's standard form and properly executed by a corporate surety licensed under the laws of North Carolina to execute such bonds. The amount of the bid bond shall be equal to **five (5) percent** of the total of the bid. The bid deposit shall be retained by the Owner if the successful bidder fails to execute the contract or fails to provide the required bonds, as stated above, within ten (10) days after the proper notice of award of the contract.

All Bidders must be prequalified by NCDOT as a Prequalified Bidder or PO Prime for their specific discipline and must comply with the requirements of the State of North Carolina and be appropriately licensed as a Contractor as provided in General Statutes Chapter 87. Before beginning work, subcontractors of all levels must be prequalified by the NCDOT to perform the specified work codes. The application to prequalify as a Prequalified Bidder, PO Prime, or as a subcontractor on any level contract can be located online and available here: <https://connect.ncdot.gov/business/Prequal/Pages/default.aspx>. The application must be completed to demonstrate sufficient ability and experience in related construction projects to perform the work, sufficient and readily available equipment to perform contracts in a timely manner and a completed Safety Index Rating Form.

Bidders are encouraged to only secure project bid documents as noted above. Neither the Owner nor the Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including any Addenda, obtained from any source other than the Engineer and their representative plan provider, QuestCDN. Each Bidder shall be responsible for the review of all addenda for the project and shall acknowledge the addenda on the bid form.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, to waive informalities, or to reject non-conforming, non-responsive, or conditional bids. The Owner reserves the right to award a contract to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder or bidders.
