Separate sealed BIDS for the *Hwy 74 Sidewalk Improvements* will be received by *Town of Marshville* at the *Town Hall* located at *201 W. Main St, Marshville, NC*, until *2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 10, 2014*.

This project will consist of the construction of *approximately 5,450 LF of 5' wide sidewalk from Flake Street, east on the south side of Hwy. 74 to Morgan Street on Hwy. 74* for the *Town of Marshville*.

The Contract Documents, consisting of Advertisement of Bids, Information for Bidders, Bid, Bid Schedule, Bid Bond, Agreement, Performance Bond, Payment Bond, Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed, Change Order, General Conditions, Specifications, Special Provisions, and Drawings may be examined at the following locations: Dodge, AGC and HCAC in Charlotte.

Plan cost is \$100.00. The plan deposit is Non Refundable.

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at *10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 3, 2014 at Town Hall*. "*Bidders are required to be prequalified with NCDOT for their specific discipline. Contractors wishing to become prequalified may obtain information through the NCDOT website at: <http://www.ncdot.gov/business/>.*"

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond prepared on the form of bid bond attached to the contract documents or a surety company's standard bid bond, duly executed by the bidder as principal and having surety thereon a surety company licensed to do business in the State of NC and listed in the latest issue of U.S. Treasury Circular 570, in the amount equal to not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid. Provisions of the security shall be as described in the Information for Bidders.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive any informalities in the bidding, award the contract in the best interest of the Owner, and/or readvertise. Performance and Payment Bonds each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price will be required of the successful bidder. The Town of Marshville is an Equal Opportunity Employer. Small businesses, minority and female-owned businesses, and North Carolina Licensed Businesses are invited to bid on this project.

The bidder must be legally qualified under the latest version and provisions of the *NC Contractor's Licensing Law* in order to be considered for the project.
