DESCRIPTION: Removal of Debris, Dead Animals and Other Hazards.

On Tuesday, September 11, 2018, a pre-bid meeting was held at the NCDOT Division 10 Division Office at 2:00 PM for the above named project. During the meeting several issues were discussed. A brief synopsis of discussed issues, questions and answers follows. A list of Attendees is attached.

Discussed Issues:

- Contract Dates: Bid Opening to be held on September 19, 2018 at 2:00 PM Date of Availability is October 1, 2018 Completion Date is September 30, 2019
- 2. Contractor must be certified with NCDOT as a Small Business Enterprise (SBE) to bid.
- 3. No Bonds are required with this contract.
- 4. Contractors must follow the instruction to bidders for their bid to be considered responsive.
- 5. Only Contractors that attended the Pre-Bid Meeting will be eligible to bid.
- 6. Contract Time will be one year with the option to renew for 2 additional one year periods.

- 7. Intermediate Contract Time #1. The Contractor shall patrol and remove Debris of all 220 miles of the routes identified on the map within a 5 calendar days. The work days are limited to Mon-Fri 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM. 40 Hours per week. LD's will be assessed as described in the proposal.
- 8. Intermediate Contract Time #2. The Contractor will be required to remove Debris and Dead Animals and Hazards on Primary and Secondary Roads within 48 hours notification from the NCDOT. LD's will be assessed at \$50 per day.
- 9. Intermediate Contract Time #3. The Contractor shall remove any reported hazard in which the NCDOT considers a major hazard within 90 minutes of notification from NCDOT. LD's will be assessed at \$50 per hour.
- 10. The Contractor will be working for the County Maintenance Engineer and should send the invoices to his office once a month.
- 11. When disposing of a dead animal with a collar, the Contractor shall record the information from the tag and provide that information to the Department.
- 12. Contractor shall document Debris and Dead Animals by taking digital photos in accordance with the contract provision.
- 13. Contractor shall dispose of all Debris and Animals in an approved landfill on the same day it is removed from the roadway. If the landfill is closed then disposal can be done on the following day.
- 14. NCDOT will be responsible for disposal charges.
- 15. Contractor shall provide landfill tickets and photographs when submitting the invoice for payment. No payment will be made without the tickets and photographs.
- 16. The quantity of dead animals and debris removed and disposed of on Primary Routes and Secondary Routes will be paid for at the contract unit price for "Patrol of Primary Routes". No additional payment will be made for removal of Debris and Dead Animals.
- 17. All trucks provided shall meet the requirements listed in the contract provisions and be outfitted with a GPS Unit with an online monitoring subscription.
- 18. The contractor shall install appropriate work zone traffic control, in accordance with the 2018 Standard Drawings and the current edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Questions & Answers:

- 1. Where is the map showing the routes to patrol? Answer: The map will be uploaded to the Division 10 letting website and will contain a weblink to access an online map with zoom in/zoom out capabilities.
- 2. Will we be expected to work on Holidays? Answer: The Contractor will not be allowed to work on NCDOT recognized holidays and shall work 8 hours per day on the remaining days. For work weeks containing holidays, Liquidated Damages will only be assessed if the Contractor fails to work 8 hours each day for the Non Holiday days.
- 3. Are we required to respond to Debris removal calls at night and on weekends? Answer: No the Contractor will be expected to work Mon-Fri 8 AM to 5 PM.
- 4. Are we responsible for Lane Closures that involve Truck Mounted Attenuators? Answer: No, the Contractor shall coordinate with the County Maintenance Engineer if a lane closure is needed to safely remove Debris. NCDOT will provide the lane closure.
- 5. Will we be responsible for removing Hazardous Chemicals from the Right of Way? Answer: No. However the Contractor shall contact the County Maintenance Engineer if any Hazardous Chemicals are found during their patrol.
- 6. The contract calls for patrolling 40 hours per week. Can we provide multiple trucks and patrol for less than 5 days? Answer: No. The Identified routes shall be patrolled 5 days a week unless there's a Holiday.
- 7. Do I get paid per hour for each truck? No. The Contractor should provide the number of trucks necessary to patrol the 220 miles of roadways and respond to removal request within the 40 hour work week.
