PROJECT NAME: CMAQ C 4918B - Turn Lane Improvements on US Highway 601 and NC Highway 3

Pursuant to NC General Statutes 143-129, sealed bids will be received by the City of Concord for the furnishing of all materials, labor, equipment and construction of the CMAQ C 4918B - Turn Lane Improvements on US Highway 601 and NC Highway 3, consisting of one contract having the following principal items:

CMAQ C 4918B - Turn Lane Improvements on US Highway 601 and NC Highway 3 consists of construction of approximately 0.5 miles of turn lane improvements and 2200 linear feet of 8-inch water main relocation in conjunction with the roadway widening on NC 3 (Union St. South)

Mailed bids will be received at the City of Concord, 850 Warren C. Coleman Boulevard, Concord, North Carolina, 28025, until 1:30p.m. on Thursday, November 6, 2014. Hand delivered bids on the day of bid opening will be received at the City of Concord, 850 Warren C. Coleman Boulevard, Concord, North Carolina, 28025 at the Alfred M Brown Operations Center Administration Building in Conference Room C until 1:30p.m. on Thursday, November 6, 2014, at which time, the BIDS will be publicly opened and read aloud.

A Bid Security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the proposed overall bid amount must accompany each proposal in order to be considered. The Bid security may be in the form of cash, a certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Concord, a Bid Bond executed by the Bidder or an acceptable Surety Agency licensed to conduct business in North Carolina. No Bid may be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of bid opening except as may be allowed under North Carolina General Statutes.

The BIDDER to whom a contract may be awarded shall fully comply with the requirements of all North Carolina General Statutes governing the practice of general contracting. No BIDDER may withdraw his BID within 90 calendar days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
