**The initial purchase order will be valid for a term of one year.**

No work will be permitted before receipt of the purchase order. No work will be permitted and no purchase order will be issued until all required bonds and prerequisite conditions and certification have been satisfied.

**Terms of the Contract**

The Contractor shall submit his bid for the initial one year term of the contract. At the option of the Department, this contract may be extended twice for a term of one year each for a maximum of three (3) terms @ one year per term. Including all renewals, the total contract expenditures shall not exceed the maximum value of \$1.2 million per year. The Engineer will notify the Contractor in writing within sixty (60) days of the original contract completion date if the contract may be extended. The Contractor must notify the Engineer in writing with in forty-five

(45) days of the original contract completion date of his acceptance or rejection of this offer. Failure on the part of the Contractor to reply will be received as a rejection of contract extension. NCDOT is under no obligation to renew this contract beyond its original one (1) year period.

All work must be accomplished during daylight hours. No night work is permitted unless specifically directed by the Engineer.

**This addendum officially becomes a part of the contract bid document and shall be submitted with the bid.**

### **GENERAL**

This contract is a Small Business Contract to provide Traffic Control Services along various routes in Division 12. (Alexander, Catawba, Cleveland, Gaston, Iredell & Lincoln County). Services shall be provided for the **Bituminous Department**.

All work and materials shall be in accordance with the provisions of the General Guidelines of this contract, the Project Special Provisions, the North Carolina Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures 2012, the North Carolina Department of Transportation Roadway Standards Drawings 2012, and the current edition of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). The Contractor shall keep himself fully informed of all Federal, State and local laws, ordinances, and regulations, and shall comply with the provisions of Section 107 of the Standard Specifications.

### **SMALL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM**

Bids are being solicited for this project under the provisions of the NCDOT's Small Business Enterprise Program.
