PROJECT SPECIAL PROVISIONS**ROADWAY****NOTES TO CONTRACTOR:**

All adjustments (Manhole, Monument, Meter, or Valve Box) will be completed prior to milling or resurfacing.

Map No. 1 US 76 (Causeway Dr.): State Forces will pre-mark locations for Crosswalk installations. (See Images located before the Bid Form). **Signing Plans for bike lanes and specified crosswalks will be provided at the Preconstruction meeting.**

Map No. 1 - US 76 (Causeway Dr.) & Map No. 2 - SR 1452 (Lumina Ave.): The Contractor shall reference the attached Pavement Marking Detail for *Hi-Visibility Crosswalk No – Track Marking Guidance* in the project plans.

Map No. 1 US 76 (Causeway Dr.): The Contractor shall be aware that existing parking space pavement markings will not be reinstalled during the pavement marking operation after resurfacing.

Maps No. 1 & 2: The Contractor shall be aware to notify the Resident Engineer, David Sawyer at phone: 910-341-2000, email: dmsawyer@ncdot.gov and the Town Manager of Wrightsville Beach, Tim Owens at phone: 910-256-7900, email: towens@towb.org two weeks prior to performing any work that will impact street parking.

Map No. 2 - SR 1452 (Lumina Ave.): Signal plans are provided in the plan set solely for the purpose of locating the Inductive Loop locations at the south end of the intersection with US 74. Signal plans for loop locations on SR 1272 (New Centre Dr.) and SR 1187 (Sanders Rd.) will be provided at the Preconstruction meeting.

Map No. 4 - SR 1187 (Saunders Rd.): The Contractor shall retain existing lane widths and restripe with 2' paved shoulders.

Map No. 5 - 10: The removal of the earth/grass material on/in the roadway pavement including encroaching material on the edge of pavement is to be removed, disposed, and considered incidental to paving.

Map No. 9 - SR 1530 (Elm St.): *Heated-in Place Thermoplastic Pavement Marking Lines (4", 90 Mils)* applied with primer sealer shall be used to delineate concrete islands referenced on plan sheet *Concrete Island Pavement Marking & Marker Detail* in the DC00448 Plan Set and will be paid as *Thermoplastic Pavement Marking Lines (4", 90 Mils)*.

Map No. 12 (NC State Port): The Contractor will provide a minimum of (2) two weeks' notice prior to starting work on the NC State Ports Authority. This site is an active port facility and coordinating with port personnel is necessary. All Patching Existing Pavement I19.0C (Mill) on State Port property will be in the range of 2 to 2.5 inches in depth. ** Workers in this classification may be entitled to a higher minimum wage under Executive Order 14026 (\$17.20) or 13658 (\$12.90). Please see the Note at the top of the wage determination for more information. Please also note that the minimum wage requirements of Executive Order 14026 are not currently being enforced as to any contract or subcontract to which the states of Texas, Louisiana, or Mississippi, including their agencies, are a party.

Note: Executive Order (EO) 13706, Establishing Paid Sick Leave for Federal Contractors applies to all contracts subject to the Davis-Bacon Act for which the contract is awarded (and any solicitation was issued) on or after January 1, 2017. If this contract is covered by the EO, the contractor must provide employees with 1 hour of paid sick leave for every 30 hours they work, up to 56 hours of paid sick leave each year. Unlisted classifications needed for work not included within the scope of the classifications listed may be added after award only as provided in the labor standards contract clauses (29 CFR 5.5(a)(1)(iii)).

The body of each wage determination lists the classification and wage rates that have been found to be prevailing for the cited type(s) of construction in the area covered by the wage determination. The classifications are listed in alphabetical order of "identifiers" that indicate whether the particular rate is a union rate (current union negotiated rate for local), a survey rate (weighted average rate) or a union average rate (weighted union average rate).

Union Rate Identifiers

A four letter classification abbreviation identifier enclosed in dotted lines beginning with characters other than "SU" or "UAVG" denotes that the union classification and rate were prevailing for that classification in the survey. Example: PLUM0198-005 07/01/2014. PLUM is

an abbreviation identifier of the union which prevailed in the survey for this classification, which in this example would be Plumbers. 0198 indicates the local union number or district council number where applicable, i.e., Plumbers Local 0198. The next number, 005 in the example, is an internal number used in processing the wage determination. 07/01/2014 is the effective date of the most current negotiated rate, which in this example is July 1, 2014.

Union prevailing wage rates are updated to reflect all rate changes in the collective bargaining agreement (CBA) governing this classification and rate.

Survey Rate Identifiers

Classifications listed under the "SU" identifier indicate that no one rate prevailed for this classification in the survey and the published rate is derived by computing a weighted average rate based on all the rates reported in the survey for that classification. As this weighted average rate includes all rates reported in the survey, it may include both union and non-union rates. Example: SULA2012-007 5/13/2014. SU indicates the rates are survey rates based on a weighted average calculation of rates and are not majority rates. LA indicates the State of Louisiana. 2012 is the year of survey on which these classifications and rates are based. The next number, 007 in the example, is an internal number used in producing the wage determination. 5/13/2014 indicates the survey completion date for the classifications and rates under that identifier.

Survey wage rates are not updated and remain in effect until a new survey is conducted.

Union Average Rate Identifiers

Classification(s) listed under the UAVG identifier indicate that no single majority rate prevailed for those classifications; however, 100% of the data reported for the classifications was union data. EXAMPLE: UAVG-OH-0010 08/29/2014. UAVG indicates that the rate is a weighted union average rate. OH indicates the state. The next number, 0010 in the example, is an internal number used in producing the wage determination. 08/29/2014 indicates the survey completion date for the classifications and rates under that identifier.

A UAVG rate will be updated once a year, usually in January of each year, to reflect a weighted average of the current negotiated/CBA rate of the union locals from which the rate is based.

WAGE DETERMINATION APPEALS PROCESS

1.) Has there been an initial decision in the matter? This can be:

- * an existing published wage determination
- * a survey underlying a wage determination
- * a Wage and Hour Division letter setting forth a position on a wage determination matter
- * a conformance (additional classification and rate) ruling

On survey related matters, initial contact, including requests for summaries of surveys, should be with the Wage and Hour National Office because National Office has responsibility for the David-Bacon survey program. If the response from this initial contact is not satisfactory, then the process described in 2.) and 3.) should be followed.

With regard to any other matter not yet ripe for the formal process described here, initial contact should be with the Branch of Construction Wage Determinations. Write to:
