On Federal Projects, The Appropriate Contractors License Shall Be Obtained Within 60 Days Of Bid Opening. C. All Required Prequalification Statements And Documents Shall Be Filed With The Contractual Services Unit At Least Four Weeks Prior To The Date Of Opening Bids.
