The North Carolina Department of Transportation is requesting bids for a Signal Maintenance Contract for Division 3 in Brunswick and New Hanover Counties. All quantities are estimates only. The Contractor is to furnish labor, material, equipment, and traffic control.

PRE-BID CONFERENCE

To ensure all prospective bidders are given an opportunity to obtain information relevant to the project, a mandatory pre-bid conference will be held on May 15, 2013 at 10:00am. The conference will be held at the Division 3 Traffic Services Conference Room, at 5504 Barbados Boulevard, Castle Hayne, NC 28429.

You must attend this pre-bid meeting and be prequalified by the NCDOT in order to have your bid considered for this project.

CONTRACT AVAILABILITY INFORMATION

The availability date for this project is July 1, 2013. The Contractor shall submit their bid for twelve months with the contract ending on June 30, 2014.

BID OPENING

Sealed bids must be received at the North Carolina Department of Transportation Division Three Engineer's Office at 5501 Barbados Boulevard, Castle Hayne, NC 28429 on June 6, 2013 by 2:00pm. Bids must be submitted on the official bid sheet included in the proposal and display the following statement on the front of the envelope:

Beginning **July 1, 2009**, any firm that wishes to perform work on Division Purchase Order Contracts as either the prime contractor or as a subcontractor on the project must be prequalified for the type of work they wish to perform. Firms that wish to bid on these projects as the prime contractor must be prequalified prior to submitting a bid. Firms that wish to perform as a subcontractor to the prime contractor must be prequalified prior to beginning work on the project.

For the purposes of prequalification, any firm that is currently prequalified as a prime or a subcontractor on central let projects for the appropriate work codes is considered eligible to work and/or bid on Purchase Order Contracts as long as other items such as bonding and license requirements for the contract are met.
