NOTICE TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

Subject: Invitation to Bid

- ***Project Description:*** Widen for Paved Shoulders, Resurface, Mill Patch and 1" Overlays in Pender County.
- ***WBS Element #:*** 3CR.20711.149

The North Carolina Department of Transportation is requesting bids to Widen for Paved Shoulders, Resurface Patching Existing Pavement (Mill) and 1" overlays on various Secondary Roads in Pender County. The project will include approximately 430 Tons of B 25.0 B Asphalt, 4,415 tons of S 9.5 B Asphalt, 1,055 tons of SF 9.5 A Asphalt, 520 tons of Patching Existing Pavement (Mill) with S 9.5 B & 248 Permanent Raised Pavement Markers. All quantities are estimates only. The Contractor is to furnish labor, material, equipment, and traffic control.

The availability date for this project is October 7, 2013. The completion date is December 6, 2013.

Sealed bids must be received in the Division 3 Engineer's Office at 5501 Barbados Blvd., Castle Hayne, North Carolina 28429 by 2:00 PM on Thursday, September 19, 2013. Entire bid package must be submitted by the contractor at the Bid Letting or the bid will be deemed irregular and rejected. Bids must be submitted on the official bid sheet included in the proposal and display the following statement on the front of the envelope:

QUOTATION FOR WBS ELEMENT # 3CR.20711.149: WIDEN FOR PAVED SHOULDERS, RESURFACE, MILL PATCH WITH S 9.5 B AND 1" OVERLAYS WITH SF 9.5 A ON SR 1114, SR 1214 & SR 1211 COUNTY TO BE OPENED AT 2:00 PM ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 2013.

Beginning **July 1, 2009**, any firm that wishes to perform work on Division Purchase Order Contracts as either the prime contractor or as a subcontractor on the project must be prequalified for the type of work they wish to perform. Firms that wish to bid on these

projects as the prime contractor must be prequalified prior to submitting a bid. Firms that wish to perform as a subcontractor to the prime contractor must be prequalified prior to beginning work on the project.

For the purposes of prequalification, any firm that is currently prequalified as a prime or a subcontractor on central let projects for the appropriate work codes is considered eligible to work and/or bid on Purchase Order Contracts as long as other items such as bonding and license requirements for the contract are met.


