#### INTERMEDIATE CONTRACT TIME NUMBER 1 AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

(2-20-07) 108 SP1 G14 A

The Contractor shall complete the required work of installing, maintaining, and removing the traffic control devices for lane closures and restoring traffic to the existing traffic pattern. The Contractor shall be allowed to close or narrow a lane of traffic on **I-95 and ramps**, only during the following times:

#### **DAY AND TIME RESTRICTIONS FOR I-95**

# For all Operations MONDAY TO THURSDAY – 8:00 PM – 7:00 AM FRIDAY TO SUNDAY – 10:00 PM – 7:00 AM

# For Concrete Slab Removal and Replacement From Week after Labor Day to Week before Memorial Day SUNDAY MIDNIGHT TO NOON FRIDAY

In addition, the Contractor <u>shall not close</u> or narrow a lane of traffic on **I-95 and ramps**, detain and/or alter the traffic flow on or during holidays, holiday weekends, special events, or any other time when traffic is unusually heavy, including the following schedules:

#### HOLIDAY AND HOLIDAY WEEKEND LANE CLOSURE RESTRICTIONS

- 1. For **unexpected occurrence** that creates unusually high traffic volumes, as directed by the Engineer.
- 2. For **New Year's Day**, between the hours of **6:30 AM** December 31<sup>st</sup> and **8:00 PM** January 2<sup>nd</sup>. If New Year's Day is on a Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Monday, then until **8:00 PM** the following Tuesday.
- 3. For Easter, between the hours of **6:30 AM** Thursday and **8:00 PM** Tuesday.
- 4. For Memorial Day, between the hours of **6:30 AM** Friday and **8:00 PM** Wednesday.
- 5. For **Independence Day**, between the hours of **6:30 AM** the Friday before the week of Independence Day and **8:00 PM** the following Monday after the week of Independence Day.
- 6. For Labor Day, between the hours of 6:30 AM Friday and 8:00 PM Wednesday.
- 7. For **Thanksgiving Day**, between the hours of **6:30 AM** Tuesday and **8:00 PM** Monday.
- 8. For **Christmas**, between the hours of **6:30 AM** the Friday before the week of Christmas Day and **8:00 PM** the following Tuesday after the week of Christmas.

Holidays and holiday weekends shall include New Year's, Easter, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas. The Contractor shall schedule his work so that lane closures will not be required during these periods, unless otherwise directed by the Engineer.

The time of availability for this intermediate contract work shall be the time the Contractor begins to install all traffic control devices for lane closures according to the time restrictions listed herein.

The completion time for this intermediate contract work shall be the time the Contractor is required to complete the removal of all traffic control devices for lane closures according to the time restrictions stated above and place traffic in the existing traffic pattern.

The liquidated damages are **Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars** (\$ 2,500.00) per hour.

### INTERMEDIATE CONTRACT TIME NUMBER 2 AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

The Contractor shall complete the required work of installing, maintaining, and removing the traffic control devices for road closures and restoring traffic to the existing traffic pattern. The Contractor <u>shall be allowed</u> to close **I-95**, only during the following time restrictions:

#### (FOR THE REPAIR OF JOINTED CONTRETE PAVEMENT SLABS)

#### DAY AND TIME RESTRICTIONS FOR I-95

#### MONDAY TO THURSDAY - 11:00 PM TO 5:00 AM

The liquidated damages are **Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars** (\$ 2500.00) per hour or any portion thereof.

#### **FUEL PRICE ADJUSTMENT:**

(11-15-05) (Rev. 2-18-14) 109-8 SPI G43

Revise the 2012 Standard Specifications as follows:

#### Page 1-83, Article 109-8, Fuel Price Adjustments, add the following:

The base index price for DIESEL #2 FUEL is \$ 1.6906 per gallon. Where any of the following are included as pay items in the contract, they will be eligible for fuel price adjustment.

CHANGES MAY BE REQUIRED WHEN PHYSICAL DIMENSIONS IN THE DETAIL DRAWINGS, STANDARD DETAILS, AND ROADWAY DETAILS ARE NOT ATTAINABLE TO MEET FIELD CONDITIONS OR RESULT IN DUPLICATE OR UNDESIRED OVERLAPPING OF DEVICES. MODIFICATION MAY INCLUDE: MOVING, SUPPLEMENTING, COVERING, OR REMOVAL OF DEVICES AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.

THE FOLLOWING GENERAL NOTES APPLY AT ALL TIMES FOR THE DURATION OF THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT EXCEPT WHEN OTHERWISE NOTED IN THE PLAN OR DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.

- 1. FOR ANY UNEXPECTED OCCURRENCE THAT CREATES UNUSUALLY HIGH TRAFFIC VOLUMES, AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- 2. FOR NEW YEAR'S DAY, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00 A.M.
  DECEMBER 31st TO 8:00 P.M. JANUARY 2ND. IF NEW
  YEAR'S DAY IS ON A FRIDAY, SATURDAY, SUNDAY, OR
  MONDAY THEN UNTIL 8:00 P.M. THE FOLLOWING TUESDAY.
- 3. FOR EASTER, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00 A.M. THURSDAY AND 8:00 P.M. TUESDAY.
- 4. FOR MEMORIAL DAY, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00 A.M. FRIDAY TO 8:00 P.M. WEDNESDAY.
- 5. FOR INDEPENDENCE DAY, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00 A.M. THE FRIDAY BEFORE THE WEEK OF INDEPENDENCE DAY AND 8:00 P.M. THE FOLLOWING MONDAY AFTER THE WEEK OF INDEPENDENCE DAY.
- 6. FOR LABOR DAY, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00 A.M. FRIDAY TO 8:00 P.M. WEDNESDAY.
- 7. FOR THANKSGIVING DAY, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00 A.M. TUESDAY AND 8:00 P.M. MONDAY.
- 8. FOR CHRISTMAS, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00 A.M. THE FRIDAY BEFORE THE WEEK OF CHRISTMAS DAY AND 8:00 P.M. THE FOLLOWING TUESDAY AFTER THE WEEK OF CHRISTMAS.



## LANE AND SHOULDER CLOSURE REQUIREMENTS

- D) REMOVE LANE CLOSURE DEVICES FROM THE LANE WHEN WORK IS NOT BEING PERFORMED BEHIND THE LANE CLOSURE OR WHEN A LANE CLOSURE IS NO LONGER NEEDED OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- E) WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING WITHIN 15 FT OF AN OPEN TRAVEL LANE, CLOSE THE NEAREST OPEN SHOULDER USING ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWING NO. 1101.04 UNLESS THE WORK AREA IS PROTECTED BY BARRIER OR GUARDRAIL OR A LANE CLOSURE IS INSTALLED.
- F) WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING ON THE SHOULDER ADJACENT TO AN UNDIVIDED FACILITY AND WITHIN 5 FT OF AN OPEN TRAVEL LANE, CLOSE THE NEAREST OPEN TRAVEL LANE USING ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWING NO. 1101.02 UNLESS THE WORK AREA IS PROTECTED BY BARRIER OR GUARDRAIL.

WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING ON THE SHOULDER ADJACENT TO A DIVIDED FACILITY AND WITHIN 10 FT OF AN OPEN TRAVEL LANE, CLOSE THE NEAREST OPEN TRAVEL LANE USING ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWING NO. 1101.02 UNLESS THE WORK AREA IS PROTECTED BY BARRIER OR GUARDRAIL.

- G) WHEN PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT ARE WORKING WITHIN A LANE OF TRAVEL OF AN UNDIVIDED OR DIVIDED FACILITY, CLOSE THE LANE ACCORDING TO THE TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT PLANS, ROADWAY STANDARD DRAWINGS, OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. CONDUCT THE WORK SO THAT ALL PERSONNEL AND/OR EQUIPMENT REMAIN WITHIN THE CLOSED TRAVEL LANE.
- H) DO NOT WORK SIMULTANEOUSLY WITHIN 15 FT ON BOTH SIDES OF AN OPEN TRAVELWAY, RAMP, OR LOOP WITHIN THE SAME LOCATION UNLESS PROTECTED WITH GUARDRAIL OR BARRIER.
- I) DO NOT INSTALL MORE THAN 1 MILE OF LANE CLOSURE ON I-95 MEASURED FROM THE BEGINNING OF THE MERGE TAPER TO THE END OF THE LANE CLOSURE.
- J) DO NOT INSTALL MORE THAN ONE LANE CLOSURE IN ANY ONE DIRECTION ON I-95.
