SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR QUOTATION
MEMORANDUM TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

The North Carolina Department of Transportation is requesting bids for the following projects in Division 5:

- **DE00091, Setup and Pave 3 Section of Secondary Roads in Wake County**
WBS Element: 5C.092111, etc.
Date of Availability: June 2, 2014; Completion Date: October 31, 2014
MBE (1%) WBE (2%)

Effective **July 1, 2009**, any firm that wishes to perform work on Division Purchase Order Contracts as either the prime contractor or as a subcontractor on the project must be prequalified for the type of work they wish to perform. Firms that wish to bid on these projects as the prime contractor must be prequalified prior to submitting your bid. Firms that wish to perform as a subcontractor to the prime contractor must be prequalified prior to beginning work on the project.

For the purposes of prequalification, any firm that is currently prequalified as a prime or a subcontractor on central let projects for the appropriate work codes is considered eligible to work and/or bid on Purchase Order Contracts as long as other items such as bonding and license requirements for the contract are met.

Information regarding the requirements to become prequalified as a Purchase Order Contract contractor, including the application to become prequalified if you are not already prequalified, can be found at the following website:


Exceptions to the above prequalification requirements are Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Contracts and Fully Operated Rental Equipment (FORE) Contracts. The requirements for eligibility on these contracts remain the same, and are not affected by the above requirements regarding prequalification.

In order to receive due consideration, your quotation must be submitted on the Bid Proposal Form and the entire proposal must be received in this office no later than **2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 23, 2014.**

Bid packages are available at https://connect.ncdot.gov/letting/Pages/Letting-List.aspx?let_type=5. The proposal shall be printed, stapled and returned in its entirety at the bid opening. Paper packages are available, if needed, in the Division Engineer's Office located at 2612 North Duke Street in Durham, North Carolina. Interested bidders should pick up bid packages at this location or they will be mailed upon request by contacting me or my staff at (919) 220-4600.

"Electronic" bidding is acceptable. If you wish to submit your bid electronically, please download the EBS file and the DBE file. Division 5 cannot accept online bids, please submit a CD of your electronic bid along with a printed, signed copy of your bid attached to the proposal.

Do NOT submit bids for the project let by Division 5 to the NCDOT Statewide Project Letting Office.
