NOTICE TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

Subject: Invitation to Bid

- ***Project Description: Furnish and Install Raised Pavement Markers on State Maintained Roads in Bladen, Columbus, Cumberland, Harnett, and Robeson Counties.***

The North Carolina Department of Transportation is requesting bids for furnishing and installing raised pavement markers on state maintained roads in Bladen, Columbus, Harnett, Cumberland and Robeson Counties. The Contractor is to furnish material, labor, equipment, and traffic control.

The availability date for this project is July 1, 2014. The completion date for this project is October 31, 2014.

Sealed bids must be received in the Contract Officer's Office at the Division 6 office at 558 Gillespie Street, Fayetteville, North Carolina by **10:00 a.m., June 4, 2014**. Bids must be submitted on the official bid sheet included in the proposal and display the following statement on the front of the envelope:

QUOTATION FOR INSTALLING RAISED PAVEMENT MARKERS ON STATE MAINTAINED ROADS IN BLADEN, COLUMBUS, HARNETT, CUMBERLAND AND ROBESON COUNTIES.

All Prospective bidders shall attend a Pre-Bid Conference at the location shown below. This conference will be conducted by Department personnel for the purpose of providing additional information about the project and to give bidders an opportunity to ask any questions they may have. No questions concerning the project will be answered by any personnel at any time except at the project showing.

Bidders shall meet at the Division 6 Conference Room at 558 Gillespie Street, Fayetteville, North Carolina on May 22, 2014 at 11:00 AM for the Pre-Bid Conference.

The North Carolina Department of Transportation, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights of 1964 (78 Stat.252) and the Regulations of the Department of Transportation (49 C.F.R., Part 21), issued pursuant to such act, hereby

notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that the contract entered into pursuant to this notice will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder without discrimination on the grounds of sex, race, color, or national origin.

Purchase Order Prequalification

Beginning **July 1, 2009**, any firm that wishes to perform work on Division Purchase Order Contracts as either the prime contractor or as a subcontractor on the project must be prequalified for the type of work they wish to perform. Firms that wish to bid on these projects as the prime contractor must be prequalified prior to submitting your bid. Firms that wish to perform as a subcontractor to the prime contractor must be prequalified prior to beginning work on the project.

For the purposes of prequalification, any firm that is currently prequalified as a prime or a subcontractor on central let projects for the appropriate work codes is considered eligible to work and/or bid on Purchase Order Contracts as long as other items such as bonding and license requirements for the contract are met.


