Pursuant to the General Statutes of North Carolina, Section 143-129, sealed proposals are invited and will be received by the Town of Chapel Hill for the furnishing of all materials, labor, equipment and construction of the C-5179, consisting of one contract having the following principal items:

Estes Drive Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvements Project – Consists of bicycle and pedestrian improvements along SR 1750 (Estes Drive) from just before NC-86 (Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard) to Caswell Road. The project will be approximately 1 mile in length and involve asphalt milling and overlay on the existing road, adding an independent raised cycle track on both sides of the road including a planting strip, constructing a 5’ sidewalk on the south side and a 10’ multi-use path on the north side. The construction will involve clearing and grubbing, grading, asphalt and concrete paving, drainage, erosion control, curb and gutter installation, signing, signal adjustments, and striping.

All work shall be performed in accordance with the North Carolina Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Roads and Structures dated January 2018 with all amendments and supplements.

Sealed bids should be submitted to the attention of Ms. Zakia Alam, Town of Chapel Hill – Business Management Department, Town Hall, 405 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Chapel Hill, North Carolina 27514 and marked **“QUOTATION FOR – C-5179 and Town of Chapel Hill Project P21-102”**.

Sealed bids will be received at the Town of Chapel Hill until 3:30 PM on May 11, 2021, by the following options:

3. Hand delivered at the bid opening to the first-floor covered parking deck

The bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud. The bid opening will be conducted at Town of Chapel Hill, 405 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Chapel Hill, NC 27514. **In order to maintain social distancing requirements, the bid opening will be held outside, on the 1st Floor of the Parking Deck. Face masks are required for anyone attending the bid opening.**

The BIDDER to whom a contract may be awarded shall fully comply with the requirements of all North Carolina General Statutes governing the practice of general contracting and the procedures for letting of public contracts.

A bid Security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the proposed overall bid amount must accompany each proposal in order to be considered. The Bid security may be in the form of cash, certified check or bank draft payable to the Town of Chapel Hill, a Bid Bond executed by the Bidder or an acceptable Surety Agency consented to conduct business in North Carolina. No Bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days from the date of bid opening except as may be allowed under North Carolina General Statutes.
