Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 143-129 and 143-128, sealed bid proposals endorsed “**Reynolds Park Rd Bridge Replacements - FB1700**” will be received by the City/County Purchasing Department, 324 City Hall, 101 N. Main Street, Winston-Salem, NC until **2:00 PM, July 19, 2016**, when all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in Room 16. The City reserves the right to waive any informalities in the bidding and to reject any or all proposals.

Bidders are required to be prequalified with NCDOT for their specific discipline. Contractors wishing to become prequalified may obtain information through the NCDOT website at: <http://www.ncdot.gov/business/>. NCDOT will approve or reject award of this contract.

Additionally, prime contractors must be properly licensed as required by Chapter 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes to bid and perform the work described herein as the general contractor and must have proper licenses under the state laws governing their respective trades at the time of bid opening.
