The prime and/or sub-consultant firm(s) shall be prequalified by the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) for all services to be provided (E.G. The Team Must "Cover" All Work Codes).

And preparation of permit application, preparation of planning document, preparation of construction contract proposal and estimates. The plans for the work listed above shall be prepared in an electronic format. All electronic files shall be in a Microstation format using Geopak software.

#### *The method of payment is LUMP SUM per project assignment.*

Any firm wishing to be considered must be properly registered with the Office of the Secretary of State and with the North Carolina Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors. Any firm proposing to use corporate subsidiaries or subcontractors must include a statement that these companies are properly registered with the NC Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors. The Engineers performing the work and in responsible charge of the work must be registered Professional Engineers in the State of North Carolina and must have a good ethical and professional standing. It will be the responsibility of the selected private firm to verify the registration of any corporate subsidiary or subcontractor prior to submitting a Statement of Qualification. The firm must have the financial ability to undertake the work and assume the liability. The selected firm will be required to furnish proof of Professional Liability insurance coverage in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000. The firm must have an adequate accounting system to identify costs chargeable to the project.

### SMALL PROFESSIONAL SERVICE FIRM (SPSF) PARTICIPATION

The NCDOT encourages the use of Small Professional Services Firms (SPSF). Small businesses determined to be eligible for participation in the SPSF program are those meeting size standards defined by Small Business Administration (SBA) regulations, 13 CFR Part

121 in Sector 54 under the North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS). The SPSF program is a race, ethnicity, and gender neutral program designed to increase the availability of contracting opportunities for small businesses on federal, state or locally funded contracts. SPSF participation is not contingent upon the funding source.

The prime consulting firm shall submit a listing of all known SPSF firms that will participate in the performance of the identified work when submitting their Statement of Qualification. The participation of SPSF firms shall be submitted on NCDOT's Sub-consultant Form RS-2. ## **PREQUALIFICATION**

NCDOT maintains a file on each qualified firm that has expressed an interest in providing professional services. Included in the file is a company brochure, a list of personnel and their qualifications, the firm's present activities, and financial qualifications as well as a sample of recently completed work.

All firms and/or any sub-consultants should submit or update their prequalification applications to NCDOT before submitting statement of qualification. If your firm and all sub-consultants have already submitted or updated this data as of July 1, 2015, please make mention of this in a Cover Letter at the time you submit the Statement of Qualification.

Even though specific DBE/MBE/WBE goals are not required for this project, the Department of Transportation is committed to providing opportunity for small and disadvantaged businesses to perform on its contracts through established Department goals. The Firm, sub-consultant and

sub-firm shall not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, color, national origin, age, disability or sex in the performance of this contract.

#### **EVALUATION**

(A copy of the evaluation matrix is attached on page 6.)

All qualified firms who submit responsive Statement of Qualifications will be considered. The evaluation of these firms will be based on the firm's overall experience, past performance, knowledge, and familiarity with type of work required, and the experience of proposed staff to perform specific work required, including any sub-consultants.

Priority consideration will be given to a firm with proposed SPSF participation, if after reviewing qualifications, all else is equal.

## FORMAT FOR SUBMISSION OF A STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATION

All Statement of Qualifications should be limited to fifteen (15) pages including the cover sheet, and shall be on 8 1/2" x 11" paper, single spaced and one sided. In order to reduce costs and to facilitate recycling; binders, dividers, tabs, etc. are prohibited. One staple in the upper left-hand corner is preferred. Statement of Qualifications containing more than fifteen pages will not be considered. Four (4) printed copies should be provided by mail or hand delivery prior to the deadline. A PDF copy is also required in order to minimize the number of printed copies being requested (on usb thumb drive or cd).

#### Section I - Cover/Introductory Letter

The Introductory Letter should be addressed to Tom Wooten. The letter should be no more than two (2) pages and should contain the following information:

- Expression of firm's interest in executing the work;
- Statement confirming firm is NCDOT registered;
- Date of most recent qualification;
- Statement of any possible conflicts of interest; and
- Summation of information contained within the statement of qualification

#### Section II - Evaluation Factors

This section is limited to five (5) pages and should contain information regarding evaluation and other factors listed in the advertisement such as:

- Identify project personnel/sub-consultants qualifications and experience;
- Understanding of project (site and structure conditions, traffic and safety concerns, etc.) Unique qualifications of key team members
- Identity type and location of similar work performed within the last three (3) years.

### Section III - Supportive Information

- This section is limited to eight (8) pages and should contain the following information: Capacity Chart/Graph (available work force);
- Organizational chart indicating personnel to be assigned by discipline;
- Resumes of key personnel;
- Names, classifications, and location(s) of the firms' North Carolina personnel and resources to be assigned to the work; and
- Other relevant information

#### APPENDICES - CONSULTANT CERTIFICATION "FORM RS-2"

This section is limited to the number of pages required to provide the requested information and should be submitted with the Proposal. Both the Prime Consultant Form RS-2 and the Subconsultant Form RS-2 are available at the "NCDOT QUICK FIND FORMS" link mentioned on page 2.

Private firms are invited to submit Statement of Qualifications for providing the requested planning and engineering services to the City by **2:00 P.M. on** *Friday January* **29, 2016**. Statement of Qualifications submitted after this deadline will not be considered. Four (4) total statement of qualifications are required. Firms submitting fewer copies will not be considered.

Firms submitting Statement of Qualifications are encouraged to carefully check them for conformance to the requirements stated above. If Statement of Qualifications do not meet these requirements, or if they are delivered to any address other than shown below, they will be disqualified. No exception will be granted.
