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The North Carolina Department of Transportation desires to engage a private consulting firm to provide Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) services for T. I. P. Project I-5877, I-5986A (C204283, WBS 47532.3.2) involving the construction and widening of I-95 from South of SR 1832 (Murphy Road - Exit 55) to North of SR 1002 (Long Branch Road - Exit 71). The project is Design-Build and will include grading, drainage, paving, structures and ITS/Signals.

Except as provided below any firm wishing to be considered must be properly registered with the Office of the Secretary of State and with the North Carolina Board of Examples for Engineers and Surveyors. Any firm proposing to use corporate subsidiaries or subcontractors must include a statement that these companies are properly registered with the Mort Carolina Board of Examiners for Engineers and Surveyors and/or the NC Board for Licensing of Geologists. Chapter 3 - Team Experience
