 CONTRACT SCOPE The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) is soliciting proposals for the services of a firm/team for the following contract scope of work.
 SCOPE OF WORK LOCATION & SURVEYS CONSULTANT SERVICES

However, other DISCIPLINE CODES may be required throughout the life of the contract(s), based on the Location & Surveys Unit's need/workload. The prequalification(s) for any "future-required" work code(s) will be reviewed on a project-specific basis, and may not be held by all consultants selected for this contract.

The consultant must be capable of providing any and all work assignments in an expedient manner.

All services listed/mentioned above shall be done in accordance with the guidelines and standards for each unit/discipline.

The work consists of obtaining survey data and base plan sheet preparation necessary for the design and/or maintenance of highway projects. Tasks may include any of the following surveying disciplines: Conventional Route Surveying, Global Positioning Surveying (GPS)/Global Navigation Satellite Systems (GNSS), Subsurface Utility Engineering (SUE), High Density Laser Scanning, and Hydrographic Surveying.

Subsurface Utility Engineering Firms must be able to provide levels of Service A, B, C, and D and must possess non-damaging excavation equipment in order to be considered for this work.

The data for the work listed above shall be prepared in electronic format. All electronic files shall be compiled with MicroStation. The version of MicroStation used must be the same version currently used by NCDOT.

GENERAL ENGINEERING SERVICES CONSULTANT (GESC):

This portion of the contract scope will likely not require the firm(s) to professionally seal any construction drawings or documents and, therefore, no specific prequalification DISCIPLINE CODES are included for this section of this solicitation.

However, selection of the Firms will, in part, be based on the breadth of prequalification of the various firm(s) in regards to the typical LOCATION AND SURVEYS services needed for the delivery of highway projects.

Assignment of LOCATION AND SURVEYS review tasks made under this contract is contingent upon the Firm being pre-qualified in the applicable DISCIPLINE CODE(s) before such assignment is made.

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) desires to retain Firms to provide LOCATION AND SURVEYS services as required under On-Call General Engineering Services Consultant (GESC) contract(s). The GESC Firms selected will provide professional consulting services to support NCDOT's Location & Surveys Unit in the development and delivery of Location & Surveys Unit managed projects and, most notably, for the review of project plans, technical reports and other deliverables submitted by other private engineering firms and third parties. Selected GESC Firms may also provide general program management support.

DEFINITION OF GESC

This contract will entail a non-authoritative General Engineering Service Contract (GESC) relationship. The GESC Firm will not have the authority to dictate the scope of work to other professional services firms retained by the Department, or to manage or participate in the selection of other professional services firms, review manday estimates from (and negotiate with) other firms, review and approve invoices, or other such tasks that are the responsibility of the NCDOT.

The GESC Firm will serve in a support and advisory role to the Location & Surveys Unit. The GESC Firm will be responsible for working with Location & Surveys to deliver multiple projects. The GESC Firm will review planning and engineering documents and other technical reports. The Firm may also provide general program management support.

RESTRICTIONS

Consistent with the NCDOT Ethics Policy, the following restrictions shall be in place for the GESC Firm as a means of avoiding potential conflicts of interest and perceived or real unfair competitive advantage:

1. Confidentiality agreements will be executed by the Firm and all participating staff.
2. Prime firms may not review any of their own work products.
3. The Firm does not have the authority to manage or participate in the selection of other professional services firms, or perform other such tasks that are the responsibility of the Department.
4. All review comments generated by this contract are to be provided directly to the Location & Surveys Office. Under no circumstances will there be any consultant-to-consultant contact with regard to the review of work products generated by other consultants.
5. In the event the Firm had a review role on a Location & Surveys Unit-managed project that is converted to Design-Build, the Firm is precluded from participating on the Contractor/Developer pursuit of that Design-Build contract, unless an exemption is granted in accordance with NCDOT's Design-Build Policy and Procedures.

Nothing in the above restrictions is intended to preclude the GESC Firm from pursuing or engaging in other work directly contracted by and between the GESC Firm, and the NCDOT (for example, performance of CEI for projects).

SCOPE OF WORK

The services to be provided by the Firm(s) include engineering review support services whereby the Firm(s) serves as a technical extension of the NCDOT's staff for the purposes of reviewing project plans, technical reports and other deliverables submitted by other professional services firms or third parties for the purposes of supporting project delivery. The Firm may also provide general program management support.

The responsibilities of the Firm(s) include, but are not limited to:

- Serve as a resource and advisor to the Location & Surveys Unit for the development of projects
 - review survey requests for determined limits and identify required tasks based on the scope of work
 - review and provide recommendations for required work, including but not limited to:
 - scoping and scheduling of work
 - quality assurance and quality control
- Support project functions
 - drafting correspondence
 - presentation preparation
 - meeting management (preparation, logistics, meeting minutes, etc.)
 - preparation of project briefs
 - training support
- Project delivery tracking and reporting on milestones
- While these contracts are primarily for the review of work performed by others, the Location & Surveys Unit may engage the Firm to perform minor survey tasks in support of the Location & Surveys staff or to offer alternative solutions for a given project.

The consultant must be capable of completing quality work assignments in an expedient manner.

All services listed/mentioned above shall be done in accordance with the guidelines and standards for the Department.

All deliverables shall be produced in the format as directed by the Location & Surveys Unit.

PROJECT MANAGER QUALIFICATIONS

The GESC Firm is intended to augment the capacity and capabilities of NCDOT Location & Surveys staff to deliver projects. Therefore, the designated Project Manager is expected to have the following knowledge, skills and abilities:

- ability to provide or secure professional surveying services expertise to review project development and design deliverables;
- experience with project delivery processes;
- project management, scheduling, tracking and performance measurement capability;
- ability to effectively communicate (written and verbal) with internal and external stakeholders/partners;
- working knowledge of federal, state and NCDOT project delivery laws, regulations, policies, standards, processes and practices; and,
- preferable (although not required), a minimum of ten (10) years of relevant transportation experience.

The work under this contract is expected to be high priority for the Project Manager; however, that does not preclude the Project Manager from working on other projects. The concept of a Project Manager is to provide the Location & Surveys Unit one conduit through which they can access all the resources of the Firm. The Firm must be positioned to efficiently and effectively be responsive to the needs of the Location & Surveys Unit.

Chapter 3 - Team Experience

This chapter must provide the names, classifications, and location of the firm's North Carolina employees and resources to be assigned to the advertised work; and the professional credentials and experience of the persons assigned to the project, along with any unique qualifications of key personnel. Although standard personnel resumes may be included, identify pertinent team experience to be applied to this project. Specifically, the Department is interested in the experience, expertise, and total quality of the consultant's proposed team. If principals of the firm will not be actively involved in the study/contract/project, do not list them. The submittal shall clearly indicate the Consultant's Project Manager, other key Team Members and his/her qualifications for the proposed work. Also, include the team's organization chart for the Project / Plan. A Capacity Chart / Graph (available work force) should also be included.
