


## **Funding Updates**





# New Guidance Tactical Guidelines for Airport Operations During Disaster Response

- Guidebook specifically designed for:
  - General aviation airports
  - Personnel
  - Emergency management partners
- Distills insights from the after-action report into tactical guidelines
- Covers preparedness, response, and recovery for future disasters, including
  - Best practices
  - Operational checklists
  - Coordination strategies

#### **New Guidance**



#### NCDOT Aviation Right of Way Manual

- Developed in coordination with the FAA and the NCDOT Right-of-Way Unit
- Mirrors federal processes for airports
- Continue using:
  - NCDOT AV-100 Checklist (page two)
  - Land Release Flowchart
- Airports must complete review appraisals and serve as the approving authority for:
  - Fair market values
  - Administrative settlement values
  - Condemnation
  - Relocation benefits

Went into effect July 1, 2025
