Inspiring the Next Generation of Aviation Talent

Talent fuels North Carolina's aviation sector.

North Carolina's public airports helped inspire the next generation of talent to pursue careers in aviation during summer 2023 by hosting aviation-focused Aviation Career Education (ACE) Academies for elementary, middle and high school students.


The N.C. Department of Transportation (NCDOT) Division of Aviation supports these summer academies with technical assistance, presentations and funding of up to \$3,000 per academy.

The 10 public airports hosting academies in 2023 exposed a diverse mix of nearly 400 students from across the state to career opportunities in the rapidly changing world of air transportation.

Students got back-stage passes to their local airports and the companies that operate on them. They learned about aviation careers from local pilots, air traffic controllers, civil air patrol members, manufacturers and military and civilian aircraft mechanics. They witnessed parachute jumps, sat inside aircraft cockpits, took the controls of aircraft simulators, and built and flew hot air balloons. They learned flight theory and how to interpret weather.

NCDOT Aviation showcased aviation career and education opportunities in North Carolina for students at each academy, offered hands-on demonstrations of drone operations and shared how NCDOT uses drones to increase safety and inefficiency and save money.
