NCDOT Division of Aviation has been supporting general aviation airports in North Carolina by providing **"NO TRESPASSING SIGNS"** to airports at no cost to them. We have updated our policy and wanted to alert you of the latest plans for providing signage:

- 1. NCDOT Aviation will continue providing airports with three different types of signs at no cost to the airports.
- 2. Airports can request up to 10 of each type of sign in a state fiscal year using the request form.

Here are the three types of signs NCDOT Aviation will provide at no cost (maximum 10 per type each state fiscal year):

1. **"NO TRESPASSING" sign:** This sign, as shown below, should be located, and installed on all airport perimeter fence gates.



Size: 18" x 24" and 30" x 24"

2. **"NO TRESPASSING: VIOLATORS WILL BE PROSECUTED" sign:** This sign, as shown below, should be located and installed on perimeter fences of the airport with a maximum spacing of 500 feet between the signs and generally where at least one sign is visible from anywhere outside the fence.



Size: 18" x 18"

3. **"RESTRICTED AREA" sign:** This sign, as shown below, should be located, and installed on gates accessing the aircraft apron(s) and terminal area(s) of the airport.
