The goal of these efforts is to have the initial prioritized enhancements fully developed, implemented, with training and tools available so that we are seeing overall improvements in project delivery by the end of 2019. Training Update

- **Project Development Roles and Responsibilities Training** *initial training sessions have been held with additional training classes being scheduled for this summer.*
- **Project Management Training** initial training sessions are underway now with a focus on the PM role as a discipline for Preconstruction PMs. Future training will be expanded to include more NCDOT Preconstruction staff and industry partners.
- MS Project Schedule Training initial training sessions are underway now. Intended for Preconstruction PMs, comprised of what is included in a schedule, why it is important, how to define the critical path, and how to utilize a schedule on a daily basis as a PM.
