Engineer's Estimates for Central Let Projects

What is the Engineer's Estimate?

- Construction cost estimate for the Final Plan quantities
- Only 1 done per project via TRNS*PORT, just prior to Letting
- Estimate is CONFIDENTIAL until Letting

Why do we need them?

- To ensure DOT gets a fair price for the work in a contract
- Estimate is used as a basis for Award or Rejection of Bids

First Step: Project Setup

- Final Estimates group sets up project in TRNS*PORT
- Setup occurs when project hits 12-month Let List
- Units have from Setup to Final Plan turn in to enter Items/Quantities

What Units provide:

- Quantities:

- Units either enter Items directly into TRNS*PORT or
- a CSV file is provided for import by the Final Estimates group (typically done for Consultant designed or DDRL projects)

- Prices:

- Roadway and Hydraulics Items are priced by Final Estimates
- Structures & Utilities enter prices directly into TRNS*PORT
- Other Central Units provide prices on pdf copy of quantities

Due Dates:

- Quantities are due 10 weeks before Bid Ad

- Units are locked out from making changes in TRNS*PORT
- Changes after turn in are coordinated through Plan Checking and Proposals

- Prices are due 5 weeks before Bid Ad

 Units submit CONFIDENTIAL prices directly to Final Estimates group (Structures and Utilities enter prices directly into TRNS*PORT, Roadway and Hydraulics items priced by Final Estimates group)
