All NCDOT MCC, PCE, CE & EA Projects



- Since 2009 NCDOT Cultural Resources Staff has reviewed <u>4500 projects</u> under the Programmatic Agreement for Minor Transportation Projects (PA).
- The PA applies to state and federallyfunded projects.
- Dept. of Natural and Cultural Resources, US Forest Service and Federal Highway Administration provided all review results on annual basis.
- USACE relies on review results

• Project submitter receives separate review forms from both Archaeology and Historic Architecture.

• Review forms have been revised for clarity — separate forms for Archaeology or Historic Architecture.

• Turnaround time for No Survey/Survey Required calls is 30 days.

- If submitter has not received response in 30 days then check with Matt, Mary Pope.
- Additional time is necessary if survey required. NCDOT Cultural Resource Teams will coordinate this with submitter
- The PA <u>does not add steps to your envi-</u> <u>ronmental review process</u> — NCDOT Cultural Resources Teams make decisions previously assigned to Dept. of Natural and Cultural Resources.

EIS Projects

EIS Projects (both State and Federal) require early coordination with the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources — State Historic Preservation Office & Office of State Archaeology.

Not processed under PA procedures

NCDOT Cultural Resources Teams respond to Department of Natural and Cultural Resources comments and ensure compliance with State and Federal Cultural Resources Regulations.

NCDOT's Cultural Resource Team representatives are happy to come to your NCDOT location to provide a training session that covers the details of the PA process and other review services.
