Question:

For English Projects, ditch elevations are being labeled to three decimal places by the Criteria. Is there a reason for the three decimal places, because it seems like it should be two decimals for English Projects?

Answer:

To be consistent with Roadway plans, labels for distance, elevation, and station should carry **two** decimal places for English Projects and **three** decimal places for Metric Projects. Through Criteria, the following cross section labels have been modified accordingly, depending if the Project is English or Metric.

- Cross Section Ditch Elevation Label (Roadway Ditch)
- Cross Section Special Ditch Elevation Label (Roadway Ditch or Hydraulic Design)
- Cross Section Slope Stake Point Elevation Label
