


12_20 Critical Driveway Linestyles Update

Question:

My driveway isn't lining up correctly with the C&G and to deduct the driveway from the C&G length, it needs the driveway to be on the curb and gutter line

Answer:


We have moved the point of origin for both driveway linestyles from the proposed EOP line to the Curb and Gutter line. See sketch below.




This request was made because on driveways, as a line or arc element, they need to line up with the curb and gutter line. This is consistent with practice of the past, when driveways were cells. The origin of driveway cells was on the curb and gutter line. Also more importantly, in order for us to deduct the driveways from the curb and gutter length, we will need the driveways to be on the curb and gutter line.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

All previous placed concrete drop and radius type driveway linestyles are to be moved from the green prop EOP line to the red curb and gutter line. See pictures below.





Since these driveways are linestyle line elements, the move parallel tool at a distance of the gutter width seems to be the best way to accomplish this.
