SUBJECT: Updated NCDOT Roadway Design Manual

The Roadway Design Unit is pleased to announce the release of the updated Roadway Design Manual which is effective immediately. The three major thrusts for this update were as follows:

- To include guidance, charts and tables from the 2018 AASHTO A Policy on Geometric Design of Highways and Streets (7th Edition).
- To review past procedural memos and guidance, evaluating the need for updates and including the relevant content. Notable updates include the Design Exception Procedure, Bridge Policy, Subregional Tier Guidance for Bridge Projects and Lighting and Electrical Guidance.
- To include relevant content on other modes of transportation
