SUBJECT:

Maintenance related pavement between outside edge of paved

shoulders and guardrail.

The purpose of paving from the outside edge of the paved shoulder to the guardrail is to reduce or eliminate the future mowing maintenance in these areas. The pavement is not designed to carry traffic. For this reason, the following pavement designs can be used:

When 2' or less:

Use shoulder design.

When 2' to 4'

Use 1" S9.5A

On 3" I19.0B.

When greater than 4',

Use 1" S9.5A

On 4" ABC.

Curb and gutter, if present, may be placed on earth for all above cases. If specialized designs are needed, please contact Judith Corley-Lay at 250-4094.
