Gary Lovering's Promotion

Jay congratulated Gary on his recent promotion to Project Engineer.

PE Compensation – Jay Bennett

PE Compensation was discussed. It should be effective October 25, for a straight sum of \$4100.00 for North Carolina Registered Professional Engineer's. Money should be in the November 21 paycheck. The compensation is for the engineering series positions and cannot exceed your maximum in grade salary. Please champion this program, this is another positive step for NC DOT.

Technician Skill Based Pay – Sykes

We expect full implementation by January 2004. The Roadway team is reviewing training that will be required for a specific skill. There will be money for FEP and HEC completion. You must take and pass the FEP and HEC courses to receive compensation. During the PM cycle the Project Engineer and Squad Leader need to assess the technician's skills, what they would like to do and any possible training they need to fulfill competency. Jim Speer and Brenda Moore are working on this information. We will make information available to everybody as soon as we can. The money for FEP will be limited to TT I and below. I assume, January 2004 will be the timetable for salary adjustments. The information on the system should be representative of their skills based on their current classification.

DOT is the only branch of State Government actively pursuing the Technician Skill Based Pay salary adjustments.

CADD – Ted Walls

Mr. Checker will be implemented in a couple of weeks. As soon as it becomes available I will let everyone know.

User Group Meeting was held on September 24. Our goal is to hold at least one meeting every three months. Plan profile sheet layout procedure should be ready.

We are in the process of trying to get a new color printer. We are aiming to set up a queue that everyone can access. We will be able to print small portions of our hearing maps. This printers paper size will be limited to 11" x 17" (maximum). Art is working on plotting procedures for preliminary design printed on orthophography backgrounds.

Plan/Design Items

Geotechnical Recommendations – Jay

We received a memorandum, dated September 17, from Njoroge Wainaina regarding requests for Geotechnical recommendations. When we make a request for Geotechnical recommendations, please include two sets of plans with each request. Our form letters were modified to accommodate this change.

Please note that slope recommendations and ground water information are often required prior to receiving final Geotechnical recommendations.

Design Exception Preparation Guidelines – Jay

I have included a cover sheet for the design exception preparation guidelines. Ron Allen and Glenn Mumford have been working on this. We need FHWA exception to include as an example for this documentation. We are trying to establish consistency as to how we prepare design exceptions. The final document should be ready in a few weeks.

Local Planning Organization – LPO

The NC DOT is starting to use LPO in lieu of MPO and RPO. There are 37 organizations combined across the state. A draft of LOP partnership guidelines was sent out a year ago for comments. Dewayne plans to schedule meetings to discuss the LPO's partnership guidelines to the Roadway Design staff. We are already sharing information with the planning organizations. You will see very little change to our processes and procedures.

The DOH reorganization was discussed. The Director positions will be posted Tuesday, October 14, for five days.
