Value Engineering Program assembles and leads multi-disciplined teams through a Value Analysis process — using guidance from the Federal Highway Administration — to explore creative ideas that can add value to project designs. The Program Manager is Haadi Sadaghiani.

Risk Assessment Program identifies potential risks associated with a project or program and develops a mitigation plan to reduce those risks. Risks could include, but are not limited to, construction liability and increased costs due to project unknowns or even opportunities. The Program Manager is Haadi Sadaghiani and support for Risk Management and the PDN is Roe Brybag, PE.

Constructability Review Program leads a multi-disciplined team, during project development, of NCDOT engineers, contractors, and stakeholders to look for possible issues that might arise, based on design, when a project is let for construction. The problems are mitigated prior to breaking ground which saves time and money during construction. Program Manager is Clare Fullerton, PE.

Value Engineering Proposals Program Per article 104-12 of the NCDOT Standard Specifications, contractors may submit VEPs that aim to save time and resources which ultimately saves money. This allows contractors to submit innovative ideas directly to NCDOT for a share of the cost savings. Program Manager is Roe Brybag, PE.

Communicate Lessons Exchange Advice Record (CLEAR) Program captures lessons learned throughout the Department and stores them in a searchable database. Employees throughout the NCDOT are encouraged to submit ideas and review the database for lessons that can be applied to their future work. The Program Manager is Clare Fullerton, PE.
