



The United States Department of Labor prevailing wage survey for North Carolina highway construction wage rates is currently underway.

What is the reporting period?

• Wage information can be provided by contractors between May 20, 2024 and August 20, 2024. The wage survey will close at midnight on August 20, 2024, and DOL will not accept any information after that point.

What projects should be reported?

- ALL eligible projects should be reported. You are encouraged to submit data for ALL (federal, state, private, etc.) construction projects that fall with the parameters of the survey.
- Even though Davis Bacon wage rates are only applicable to federally funded contracts, we encourage all contractors to report their wage rates on all applicable contracts to maximize participation.

Who can report?

- Any contractor who worked on a contract that was active between May 20, 2023, and August 20, 2024 can report
 wages for those contracts.
- If a contract was accepted by NCDOT on May 21, 2023, a contractor should still report their employee's wages, regardless of when the contract was awarded or if the work took place prior to May 20, 2023.

Why is this important?

- Insufficient reporting can result in DOL setting the new wage rate determinations with rates based on who has reported.
- Rates that are higher than the statewide average can result in higher labor costs for contractors.
