

Application Modifications and Enhancements

HiCAMS and DOH Vendor Versions 7.1.2 were released Thursday, September 25, 2008.

HiCAMS - General

- An alert will be shown at the time a user logs in whenever he/she has unopened Notifications.
- A new menu option has been added for a link to the User Guide from the HiCAMS application. It can be found under the menu choice Help > User Guide.
- Corrected the Contract Selection pop-up window to have the default Contract Status value be "Active" throughout the application.

CONTRACT MAINTENANCE - Review Contract Details

- Corrected a problem that caused some contracts not to have a Regional Category Code assigned during Contract Authorization. Those contracts that were missing their Regional Category Code were corrected as part of conversion during the release implementation.
- On the Status tab, the field previously called "Current Retainage Amount" has been renamed to "Retainage". The amount continues to reflect the total retainage dollars withheld up through the estimate shown on this tab.
- On the Status tab, the field previously called "Liquidated Damages Held Amount" has been renamed to "Assessed Liquidated Damages". This amount continues to reflect the total damages assessed up through the estimate shown on this tab.
- On the CCU tab, the Logged By display was corrected to show the user's name rather than user id.
- On the History tab, corrected the right-mouseclick Sort function to include all field names on tab and to default the sort by Action Date.

CONTRACT ESTIMATES - Generate Estimate

- Adjusted the right-mouseclick default sort on the History tab to be by Action Date descending.

CONTRACT ESTIMATES - Review Estimates

- Adjusted the right-mouseclick default sort on the History tab to be by Action Date descending.
- Corrected a problem for contracts that had their line item indicators reset that caused the printed estimate and contractor copy of the estimate to show incorrect unit prices for AC adjustments. This was a reporting display problem only. All estimates have calculated and paid any price adjustments accurately.

FIELD INSPECTION REPORTS (FIR) - General

- If "Save As" or "New" functions are selected for a Section Code that is expired, that section code will not be carried forward to the new record. A new, unexpired section code must be selected on the new FIR record.
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FIELD INSPECTION REPORTS (FIR) - Review Field Inspection Reports

- PRESTRESSED CONCRETE: Corrected a problem that caused the material to change after tabbing out of the field. This had caused several residual problems in the data entry process.

QUERY TOOL

- JOB MIX FORMULA: The fields previously listed as “0.300 mm” and “0.600 mm” were changed to read “Sieve 0.300 mm” and “Sieve 0.600 mm”.
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STANDARD REPORTS - Contract Claims

- Modified the report to show the minimum TIP number in the detail of the report rather than redundantly showing multiple rows for contracts having multiple TIP numbers.

STANDARD REPORTS - Contract Level of Service Report

- Renamed the “Begin Date” and “End Date” parameter labels to be “Final Estimate Paid Begin Date” and “Final Estimate Paid End Date”, respectively.
- In the LOS Description section, the labels for the “... contract completion date*” have been modified to read “... contract Target Completion Date*” for each level.
- In the definition section at the bottom of the report page, the text “*Completion Date = ...” has been modified to read “*Target Completion Date = ...”.
