

Application Modifications and Enhancements

HiCAMS and DOH Vendor Versions 8.3.1 were released Friday, January 11, 2013

OVERVIEW OF THE RELEASE

HiCAMS Version 8.3.1 is comprised of technical enhancements as well as application fixes to some production problems in Project Certification and Project Closeout (CQI).

HiCAMS - General

- In preparation for a server upgrade, changes have been made to the Upgrade procedure for HiCAMS and DOH Vendor. Now, one install action accomplishes the upgrade for both parts of the application.
- Reordered the Contract Maintenance Functions and made the Menu item consistent with HiCAMS standards.

CONTRACT MAINTENANCE - Authorize Contracts

- Removed Project Closeout and Project Certification functions from the Verify flyout menus.
- Corrected access issues with the Verify WBS functionality.

CONTRACT ESTIMATES - Review Estimates

- Added support for Windows 7 to the Estimate Approval process.

DENSITY - Review Density Asphalt Cores QC

- Corrected the Save Action so that the last core density result stays populated on the Results tab.

PROJECT CERTIFICATION - Review Material Pre-Certification

- Added a new version of the Final Letter to be used on 100% State Funded contracts.
- Added the ability to change the letter's addressee if needed and added a new Function called "Review Address Maintenance" in the Project Certification module.
- Corrected calculations so that the Theoretical Non Compliance Amounts displayed in the Material Precert window and Project Cert Status letter match.

PROJECT CLOSEOUT - Review Construction Quality Index

- Updated the Save action so that the correct user id is picked up on the History Tab
- Corrected the window so that it is no longer possible to enter Evaluation data without entering at least one Design Engineer.

QUERY TOOL

- CONTRACTS: Corrected the Query to eliminate duplicate CQI rows being returned.

DOH Vendor ADMIN - Codes Table

- APPRENTICESHIPS: Apprenticeships code table was repurposed but never properly renamed which was causing a GPF error. The Code Table has been properly renamed "M&T Assessment Program" and is now updateable.
