



<sup>\*</sup>Safety scores are based on three components: the class density ratio, the severity index, and the critical crash rate ratio. The points are averaged and grouped into three point ranges where higher scores are considered to have the poorer highway safety performance. Routes having a mileposted crash percentage of 60% or lower were not scored.

Safety data is only displayed on STC Corridor P and relevant crossroads and parallel routes.




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
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
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
