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### 1. Introduction

In 2015, the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) identified a network of key multimodal transportation corridors called Strategic Transportation Corridors (STC) to support smart planning, help set long-term investment decisions, and ensure that North Carolina's economic prosperity goals are achieved. The STCs are intended to promote transportation system connectivity, provide high levels of mobility, and improve access to important state and regional activity centers. A key element in the advancement of the STCs is the development of corridor master plan visions.

The purpose of the master plan visions is to:

- · identify high-level corridor mobility visions and associated improvement strategies,
- guide improvements and development in a manner that defines a long-term vision and performance level for the corridors, and
- help protect the corridor's key functions as defined in the corridor profiles.

NCDOT has initiated the development of master plans for STC P, S, and X.

- Corridor P: Future I-42 follows U.S. 70E and the North Carolina Railroad (NCRR) from I-440 in Wake County to the Port of Morehead City.
- Corridor S: Future I-795 follows existing I-795 and U.S. 117 from I-95 in Wilson County to I-40 in Sampson County.
- Corridor X: Jacksonville to Greenville follows U.S. 258, N.C. 11, and U.S. 13 from U.S. 17 in Onslow County to U.S. 64 in Edgecombe County.

The development of the master plan vision developments depends on the availability of complete, current, and reliable data. All data sources for this memorandum are listed in the *STC Vision Plans Data Collection Plan for Corridors P, S, and X*. The data collected from transportation plans for Corridors P, S, and X identifies anticipated improvements and expansion of the transportation system.

### 2. Methodology

Transportation plans and recommended projects were compiled from all jurisdictions along the P, S, and X Corridors, including projects in the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), Comprehensive Transportation Plans (CTP), Long Range Transportation Plans (LRTP), Metropolitan Transportation Plans (MTP), feasibility studies, and traffic forecasts. All projects and recommendations, including highway, bicycle/pedestrian and transit projects, along the corridors or any bypass, business, or alternate route to the corridors were included. Projects that cross the main corridors but do not make changes to the intersection/interchange or the corridor were not included.

STIP projects were compiled on October 1, 2019 from the NCDOT connect site and current STIP document dated September 2019. The latest adopted CTP reports and maps were collected on September 12, 2019 along the corridors from the NCDOT Connect site.

MTP and LRTP reports and appendices were collected on September 12, 2019 for each Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) along the corridors. The following MTP reports were collected for Future I-42:

- Capital Area MPO and Durham Chapel-Hill Carrboro MPO MTP
- Goldsboro MTP
- New Bern Area MTP
- Research Triangle Region MTP

The Goldsboro MTP report was collected for Future I-795. The Greenville MTP and Jacksonville Urban Area LRTP reports were collected for route U.S. 258/N.C. 11/U.S. 13.

All feasibility studies along the corridors were requested from the Feasibility Studies Unit on October 1, 2019. All feasibility studies within the past ten years along the corridors or any bypass, business, or alternate routes to the corridors were compiled along with their recommendations.

All traffic forecasts within the past five years or currently in progress were collected from the NCDOT ArcGIS viewer on October 1, 2019. All forecasts along the corridors or any bypass, business, or alternate routes to the corridors were included.

### 3. Corridor P: Future I-42

The 18 currently identified 2020-2029 STIP projects along Future I-42 are shown in Appendix A in **Table A-1** with right of way, construction status, and a detailed description included. The six identified feasibility studies within the past ten years along Future I-42 are shown in Appendix A in **Table A-2** including detailed descriptions of each study along with their recommendations. The 17 identified traffic forecasts within the past five years along Future I-42 are shown in Appendix A in **Table A-3** including detailed descriptions of each forecast along with their associated project.

Corridor maps of the current proposed facilities from the CTPs along Future I-42 are shown in **Figures 1A-1F** starting on page 5. Recommendation data is missing from U.S. 70 near the Town of Princeton because the Town was not included in the Johnston County CTP. Recommendation data is also missing from U.S. 70 in Craven County in the areas that were not included in the New Bern Area MPO MTP. Through the majority of Johnston, Wayne, Lenoir, and Jones counties, U.S. 70 is classified as either a proposed freeway, a freeway that needs improvement, or an existing freeway. In Carteret County the classification changes to an existing boulevard and at the U.S. 70/U.S. 24 junction, the classification becomes a boulevard that needs improvement. A comprehensive list of recommendations along the U.S. 321 portion of Future I-42 from the CTPs is shown in Appendix A in **Table A-4**. Recommendations from the MTPs along Future I-42 are shown in Appendix A in **Table A-5**.



### 4. Corridor S: Future I-795

The 13 currently identified 2020-2029 STIP projects along Future I-795 are shown in Appendix B in **Table B-1** with right of way, construction status, and a detailed description included. The one identified feasibility study within the past ten years along Future I-795 is shown in Appendix B in **Table B-2** including a detailed description of the study along with its recommendations. The two identified traffic forecasts within the past five years along Future I-795 are shown in Appendix B in **Table B-3** including detailed descriptions of each forecast along with their associated project.


Corridor maps of the current proposed facilities from the CTPs along Future I-795 are shown in **Figures 2A-2B** starting on page 12. Almost the entire corridor is classified as a proposed freeway, a freeway that needs improvement, and as an existing freeway. The section of U.S. 117 in Sampson County is classified as an existing expressway. A comprehensive list of recommendations along Future I-795 from the CTPs is shown in Appendix B in **Table B-4**. The recommendation from the MTP along Future I-795 is shown in Appendix B in **Table B-5**.


### 5. Corridor X: U.S. 258/N.C. 11/U.S. 13



The four identified feasibility studies within the past ten years along route U.S. 258/N.C. 11/U.S. 13 are shown in Appendix C in **Table C-2** including detailed descriptions of each study along with their recommendations. The eight identified traffic forecasts within the past five years along route U.S. 258/N.C. 11/U.S. 13 are shown in Appendix C in **Table C-3** including detailed descriptions of each forecast along with their associated project.


Corridor maps of the current proposed facilities from the CTPs along route U.S. 258/N.C. 11/U.S. 13 are shown in **Figures 3A-3C** starting on page 15. Recommendation data is missing near the Town of Bethel and the Town of Grifton because these towns were not included in the Pitt County or Greenville MPO CTPs, respectively. Recommendation data is also missing from Onslow County because the Jacksonville Urban Area LRTP did not include recommendations. Through Pitt County and into Lenoir County, U.S. 13 and N.C. 11 are classified as freeways needing improvement or existing boulevards. South of Kinston to the Jones County line, N.C. 11 is classified as a boulevard needing improvement and a major thoroughfare that needs improvement. A comprehensive list of recommendations along route U.S. 258/N.C. 11/U.S. 13 from the CTPs is shown in Appendix C in **Table C-4**. Recommendations from the LRTP and MTP along route U.S. 258/N.C. 11/U.S. 13, including highway, bicycle, pedestrian, and transit, are shown in Appendix C in **Table C-5**.


# Corridor P: Future I-42 Recommendation Maps





















# **Corridor S: Future I-795 Recommendation Maps**








