1. Base Year Roadway Network Review
  - a. Dan Newquist asked if Old Georgetown Rd is included in the Base Year network
    - i. Old Georgetown Rd is included in the base year network.
  - b. Request for roads to be numbered for Steering Committee to review
    - i. Base Year Network List will be updated with the roadway numbers.
  - c. CTP Team will ensure coordination with WMPO and Surrounding county plans for the roadway network.
  - d. Ash-Little River Rd (SR 1300) was mentioned as a road that will increase in volume. It is currently included in the Base Year Network.
  - e. Benton Rd (SR 1502) will be added to the Base Year Network.
  - f. Green Lewis Rd (SR 1512) will be added to the Base Year Network.
  - g. Fifty Lakes Dr to be updated on the network roadway list. We realized Fifty Lakes was already on the list but the to and from roads were not accurate. Engineers indicated they would update this.
  - h. Governors Road (SR 1521) was mentioned and is currently included in the Base Year Network.
  - i. Pireway Rd (NC 904) was mentioned and is currently included in the Base Year Network.
2. Survey Outreach Ideas
  - a. Survey is open March 11<sup>th</sup> to June 9<sup>th</sup> for a 90-day period.
  - b. Post on organization website.

  - n. Novant Hospital.

o. Volunteer Fire Department and EMS.
