Summary of Agenda Items:

During the meeting the following items were discussed:

Linda Dosse opened the meeting for the CTP update.

The first item discussed was if there were any last minute changes to the CTP maps after Linda had updated the information from the April meeting. Although he was not at the meeting the CK Rider director had made some additional comments about the PT&R maps.

The second item discussed was the alternatives analysis the impact of the smaller US 52 bypasses around Granite Quarry, Rockwell, and Misenheimer with and without the Eastern Rowan Connector in place. Also, a possible alignment for an extension of the Westside Bypass between NC 152 and US 70. After review of the results by Rowan County and Salisbury, it was decided that the Eastern Rowan Connector and the US 52 bypasses would both be left on

the draft Highway maps and the extension of the Westside Bypass would not be included on the CTP this time around.

The third item was discussion of the presentation of the draft CTP to the TCC/TAC and then to the public. After much discussion, it was decided that because of the possibility of no June, 2015 meetings that the CTP would be presented to the TAC the next week at the May meeting and the CTP would be presented to the public at the same time as the amendments to the MPO's MTP. There will be one Cabarrus County meeting and one Rowan County meeting.

Even though there may not be a June TCC meeting Linda reserved the right to hold a Steering Committee meeting if necessary. Otherwise the next meeting will be August 19, 2015.
