

Morganton Rd and Bonanza Dr are projected to be over capacity by year 2045. Improvements are needed to relieve congestion on the existing facility and accommodate projected traffic volumes such that a minimum of Level of Service (LOS) D can be achieved.

Upgrade to multi-lane facility, add raised median and remove the center left turn lane. Include Intersection improvement to alleviate the congestion.




