Mr. Young mentioned the possibilities for connections with Fort Bragg. Mr. Joel Strickland stated that there has been interest to see a designated bicycle route on NC 210 from Spring Lake into Lillington.

Mr. Bray gave a brief description of how he planned to do the bicycle and pedestrian maps and the challenges that may come from it.
