Ms. Maurizia Chapman stated that NC 210 is currently not included in the FAMPO Long Range Transportation Plan because of timetables, but it will be changed to include the NC 210 corridor. Mr. Charles Young asked if the RPO had identified NC 210 as a project, to which Mr. Joel Strickland replied they had. Mr. Strickland stated that the RPO has the NC 210 project listed on their future TIP list and they would

work with FAMPO to assure that the projects would be uniform across the region. Mr. Lee Jernigan where the recommendation for NC 87 had come from, to which Mr. Bray stated it was identified as an expressway in the State Highway Corridor map. Mr. Young mentioned the STRAHNET corridors also.
