



















Where are we in the process?



DRAFT Lenoir County CTP Recommendations (in and around Pink Hill)

- Highway Recommendations
 - NC 11 (Center Left-turn lanes) (Not recommending bypass) (LENO0102-H)
 - NC 241 (from Duplin County to Old Beulaville Rd/Pink Hill Town Limits widen to 12 foot lanes with paved shoulder) (LENO0106-H)
- Public Transportation and Rail Recommendations
 - Park and Ride Lot near NC 11/Ash Davis Rd
- Bicycle Recommendations
 - Lenoir County Bicycle Route 43
 - Lenoir County Bicycle Route 45
- Pedestrian and Multi-Use Path Recommendations
 - NC 11, from Duplin County to Rosewood Drive
 - Central Avenue, from Macon Street to NC 11
