



Major Highway Recommendations

• I-42/US 70 Upgrade to Interstate

- Interchange near Willie Measley Rd (R-5813)
- Kinston Bypass
- US 258
 - Southern Lenoir (Alternating passing lane, safety measures)
 - South of Kinston Bypass (Widen to 4-lane divided boulevard)
 - Northern Lenoir (Widen to 4-lane divided expressway)
- NC 11
 - Pink Hill (Center Left-turn lanes)
 - Eastern Bypass/Freeway (FS-0802A)/NC 55 Realignment
 - Northern Lenoir (Upgrade to Freeway)
- NC 148
 - US 258 to NC 58 (Upgrade to freeway, new interchanges at Poole Rd and Airport Rd)
 - Harvey Parkway Extension
- Banks School Rd (Lane Width Improvements along entire facility and Operational Improvements around Bethel Christian Academy)
- Carey Rd Extension (4-lane divided boulevard)
- Cunningham Rd Extension (2-lane facility)
- Spine Rd New Construction (4-lane divided boulevard)

Minor Widening and Other Operational Improvements

- NC 55 (Wayne County to NC 11, including operational improvements at the NC 11/NC 55 intersection)
- NC 241 (Duplin County to Old Beulaville Rd/Pink Hill Town Limits
- NC 903 South (Duplin County to Jenny Lend Rd, south of US 70)
- NC 903 North (La Grange Northern Town Limits to Greene County)
- Hugo Rd (NC 58 to Greene County)
- Paul's Path Rd (Greene County to US 258)
- E Railroad Street/Fields Station Rd (0.1 miles east of N. Carey Street to Willie Measley Rd

- US 70/US 258 Overpass with Square-Loop Design (FS-1502A in Kinston)
- NC 58 Restriping (Summit Ave to Highland Ave in Kinston)
- Airport Rd (Academy Heights Rd to Dobbs Farm Rd)
- Secrest Bridge (Connecting S. Secrest St and Forrest St)
- W. Highland Ave/N/ Herritage Street intersection realignment

Public Transportation and Rail Recommendations

Rail

 Global TransPark Connector (from Global TransPark Railroad Line to CSX Railroad Line near NC 11)

Public Transportation

- Fixed Bus Route Service that connects:
 - Electrolux Manufacturing Plant/Sanderson Farms Processing Plant/Smithfield Packaging Plant
 - Walmart and surrounding commercial areas along US 70/US 258 (W. Vernon Ave)
 - Caswell Development Center
 - Vernon Park Mall
 - Commercial business along Business US 70/Business US 258 (W. Vernon Ave)
 - Residential neighborhoods and commercial developments north of downtown Kinston
 - UNC Lenoir Health Care Hospital and surrounding medical facilities
 - Downtown Kinston
 - Residential neighborhoods east of downtown Kinston
 - Commercial areas along US 70 (E. New Bern Road)
 - Lenoir Community College
 - Amtrak Thruway Station at the Kinston-Lenoir County Visitor Center

• Park and Ride Lots

- La Grange (near E. Washington St/Robina Dr)
- Pink Hill (near NC 11/Ash Davis Rd)

Bicycle Recommendations

- Curb and Gutter sections: 5-foot bicycle lanes or 14-foot wide lanes**
- No Curb and Gutter: 4-foot paved shoulder**
- ** Improvements only where applicable and/or possible

- State Bicycle Route 7
- Lenoir County Bicycle Route 40
- Lenoir County Bicycle Route 41
- Lenoir County Bicycle Route 42
- Lenoir County Bicycle Route 43
- Lenoir County Bicycle Route 44

Pedestrian and Multi-Use Path Recommendations

- 2008 City of Kinston Comprehensive Transportation Plan
- 2015 Kinston Riverfront Greenway and Cycle Track Plan
- North Carolina Mountains to Sea Trail (along the Neuse River in Lenoir County)

Other Pedestrian Improvements

- Sidewalks Needs Improvement (Sidewalks needed on one side of a facility)
 - E. Washington Street, from Carey Street to 0.1 miles east of Robina Drive
- Sidewalks Recommended (Sidewalks needed on one or both sides of a facility)
 - E. Washington Street, from 0.1 miles east of Robina Drive to Franklin Street
 - N. Hadden Street, from W. Railroad Street to Martin Luther King Junior Drive

- July/August, 2018 NCDOT Transportation Planning Division recommends CTP to the North Carolina Board of Transportation
- August/September, 2018 North Carolina Board of Transportation Mutually Adopts the Lenoir County Comprehensive Transportation Plan
- August/September, 2018 Lenoir County CTP Report produced and distributed
