







# Isothermal Regional Comprehensive Transportation Plan

February 12, 2020 Meeting Summary

# 1. Survey Status

- Karyl mentioned that if we put together a blurb with the link, she will put it out as a press release/put into local paper for advertisement.
- Survey was extended until end of March

#### 2. CTP Vision Statement and Goals

- Committee agreed with Vision Statement
- The following edits were made to Goals & Objectives (amended document will be attached):
  - i. Goal 1, Objective C: Deleted "20"
  - ii. Goal 5, Objective A: Added "future" in front of "interstates"
  - iii. Goal 5, Objective B: Deleted "interstates"
  - iv. Goal 5, Objective C: Added I-26 & I-40 as gateways
  - v. Goal 6: Added new objective regarding wildlife corridors (stemmed from conversation about bears)

### 3. Highway Deficiencies

#### **Action Items**

- 1. Investigate how our capacities are generated and whether we can use updated SPOT capacities
- 2. Investigate methodology of Rutherford Model, particularly around the Rutherford Bypass and the fact that Forest City/Spindale routes (Railroad Ave/Charlotte Rd) are over capacity in 2045. Could we rerun model with other assumptions?

### **General Discussion**

- Hannah Cook (DPE, Div 13) brought up new capacities as used by SPOT (Joe Hummer just completed). There was concern that we would be "outdated" immediately
- Some labels are not clear or are pointing to wrong thing (Rutherford maps, arrows cross each other; McDowell Map: US 70). Fix SR/Local street labels not showing

#### McDowell County

- 1. Small section of "over capacity" on Sugar Hill Rd (that isn't actually) will be addressed by bridge replacement→will be 3-lane bridge
- 2. Potential for Bat Cave Rd project in Old Fort, south of I-40 (over capacity by 2045, near capacity in 2017)
- 3. US 221 & 70 capacities seem to have changed base year to future year (what's going on with that?)

Polk County – same maps as the 15 January 2020 meeting. No new discussion.

## Rutherford County

- 1. Committee was surprised that even after Rutherford Bypass, Forest City/Spindale routes (US 74-A, 221A) were still over capacity.
- 2. Rutherford County Middle School is moving to where the High School is
  - a. Old Middle School will then be turned into Bus Depot/Terminal

# 4. Non-Highway Mode Plans

<u>In short</u>: The current plan, agreed to by the committee, is to reference all plans and add other projects to the corresponding maps

- Committee concurs that any bike/ped already in a plan should be referenced/greyed out on maps, EXCEPT those that are new additions
- List of all plans (including aviation) should be provided, with links, but linework NOT shown on map (except for new additions)
- Feeling was that all past CTPs are considered "existing plans" w.r.t SPOT
- Public Transportation/Rail should have existing deviated-fixed-route system
- Push for Passenger Rail from Asheville → Salisbury to be added as recommendation (mayor of Marion chairs that committee)
